She arrived in Jerusalem on August 1, 2023 for a 3 year tour of service. Within weeks of her arrival, Hamas militants attacked Israeli communities near Gaza, killing 1,200 people and taking several hundred hostages. Israel responded and has killed over 40,000 Gazans.

Rev. Eesley and her colleagues have started a bi-monthly zoom meeting to hear more about the situation and to dialogue with Palestinian Christians.

In this new year, I encourage you to engage with Rev. Eesley and the important work that she is doing in the Holy Land. On a personal note, I have learned so much more about the complicated situation in the Middle East.

If you are interested in joining the zoom meeting (which includes personal stories and a time of prayer) please let me know. I would be happy to share the information with you.



#### **FINANCE**

As we near the end of 2024, the financial picture for the year is becoming clear. We still have the Christmas service and one Sunday service to receive pledges and gifts, but most of our bills for the year have been paid. This is where I see our finances at the end of 2024:

Our budget income will be very close to the budgeted amount of \$289k.

Last week church council voted to pay our 2024 apportionment in full, even though that will put us in a deficit position for the year. With this payment, our expenses for the year will be \$313k, which is \$6k less than the budget amount of \$319k.

In spite of the 2024 budget deficit, we are still in good financial condition. Our assets include \$90k designated for capital expenditures, \$10k designated for ongoing programs, and \$110k of undesignated funds.

In addition to that we have restricted funds in two more accounts: nearly \$50k in the Memorials account, and just over \$400k in the Endowment account.

As we approach 2025, the finance committee is well aware of challenges and is working to improve our income relative to expenses. Pledges for 2025 are up from 2024 and we thank you for that.

We look forward to the fruitful ministry God is going to do in and through Grace UMC in the upcoming year!
