Pastor's Page

Grace and peace to you! This Sunday we will be celebrating our Confirmands as well as blessing our ASP Team as they prepare to go to Kentucky to serve on behalf of our church to the people of Breathitt County. Jesus has given us all gifts to utilize for the Kin-dom of God.

1 Peter 4:10-11 says, "Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised through Jesus Christ. To him be the glory and the power for ever and ever. Amen."

This is the time of year that our Nomination Committee begins to have conversations with people to see where their gifts and passions may connect with ministries here at church. Each year we have "classes" of people who are set to rotate off a committee of ministry that they serve on to have a break to rest, to be filled with the Spirit for all they have poured out or to engage in another area of ministry. That leaves space for others to come and be part of these life-giving ministries of the church.

Here are some of the ministry areas with a brief description and when they meet. Next month I will highlight several more.

<u>Staff Parish Relations Committee</u>: Serves a key role in establishing and sustaining the ministry focus of the pastors and staff in relationship to the congregation. (Meets first Monday evening of the Month, usually in person)

<u>Trustees</u>: Serves to guard and guide the church's ministry and facilities. (Meets 2nd Tuesday evenings of Odd months in person)

<u>Finance</u>: This Committee raises, manages and disburses the funds of the congregation to help realize the mission and vision of the Church. (Meets the 4th Tuesday evening of the month by Zoom)

*Additionally, we are looking for someone to perform an audit of our financial records. It does not need to be an accountant. Additional information is available with Pastor Laura.

Nominations: This team identifies, develops, deploys and evaluates Christan spiritual leaders to serve from their strengths and gifts. (meets in accordance to the members' availability every month from late summer through fall).

<u>Church Council:</u> This Committee is compromised of the leaders/chairs of each of our committees as well as a few "at-large" (not representing a specific committee or role) persons. This committee looks at the overall mission and ministry of the church. They cast the vision of the church, establish goals, plan, implement and evaluate the mission and ministry of the church and functions as the administrative agency of the charge conference. (Meets the 4th Thursday evenings of every other month, alternating meeting via zoom or in person)

I would ask that each of you pray about where God might be calling you to serve. While conversations and phone calls will begin in the upcoming months, the new "classes" of leaders will begin January 2026.

May we all seek to claim the gifts God has given us and use them for the glory of God.

Join us again in September.






How it Works-


GRACE SCHOLARSHIPS PRESENTATION


