

JUDGE'S COMMENTS

2D Awards

1st Place: Eileen Shaloum - Moon at My Window

"Great storytelling acrylic, well-excited, wonderful color palette, good coverage of lights, middle and dark value, nice repeating shapes, patterns and symmetry."

2nd Place: Sami Davidson -

Hidden Figure

"Nice collage effect, great balance between the overall large (hidden figure) and the numerous smaller figures. I enjoyed the story telling effect with this abstract form with the deep tones and rich colors and white relief to create what I call that stopped at a distance and pulled the viewer closer the see and enjoy the 'Hidden Figure' details."

3rd Place: Janet Schwartz -

Life's Progression 1

"The journey this abstract takes the viewer with the simple color palette, large forms that pull you throughout the piece. The juxtaposing nongeometric shapes of limited palette colors work together to create an interesting trip in wonderland."

Honorable Mention: Andrea Facusse - *Target Practice*

"I have to say that this painting is 'fun' and 'playful' with its play of color, interesting dominance of the center of interest and it's deadly 'points' of surprise at the end. This art is an allegory or metaphor - containing more than one meaning, I would like the artist to share the meaning with me, or maybe I don't."

3D Awards

1st Place: Nadine Saitlin - Gremlin Landscape

"I am in awe with the control these pieces have in this artist collection entry. I singled this piece from the others because 1) the title and 2) the color palette. Nice shape (the others as well) and the drawing of shape, almost geometric but very graphic telling a story almost referencing with early Greek/Egyptian/Roman pottery but brought forward in time to current times."

Honorable Mention: Sandy Ryter - Daisy Love

"I was drawn to this 3D piece for a number of reasons. The hand painting on the face was a nice surprise, delicate and well executed, matching the handling and color choices on the beans. The addition of the metal butterfly and button were the crowning glory."
