ROBERTA "BOBBIE" GALEX April 1938 – December 2022

Roberta "Bobbie" Galex became active in Women in the Visual Arts (WITVA), serving for a time as co-president. She founded a program called **HOSPITALART**, which provided hundreds of pieces for display at Boca Raton area hospitals, clinics, and related facilities. "I felt like I was in solitary. I had nothing to see," she told the Palm Beach Post about her illness. "It is so frightening to have just a white wall. There was nothing to take your mind off your troubles."

The inspiration for my abstract imagery comes from everywhere. Primary and contrasting colors, moving lines, and overlapping invented shapes create dynamic patterns and intricate designs. Each side reveals a variety of images, allowing a new display to the variety of images.

Artworks are executed with acrylic paint on a third dimensional gourd. Redefining the use of the natural plant gourd as a third dimensional canvas. A member of the pumpkin family, the gourd is first dried, opened, and the seeds removed before being primed, with acrylic paint, and finished with a protective matte varnish. The interior is varnished but should not be used with liquids.
