**1**. Call to all WITVA members to submit your completed application entering up to two (2) entries along with a JPEG of each artwork to Lee Krull at idesign@gate.net by October 4, 2022.

**2.** Work needs to be new to the gallery, and the gallery has the right to reject the work if deemed inappropriate for their audience. No nudes please.

**3.** Paper media must be covered and have undamaged frames and mats.

**4.** All work must be secured with taped wires. No sawtooth hangers, please.

**5.** Minimum size is 18" by 24" and maximum size is 48" by 36" (Only <u>one</u> maximum piece allowed.)

**6.** Pedestals will be provided for sculpture and locked cases for jewelry.

**7.** Note: 22% commission on sales with 10% to WITVA's Scholarship Fund and 12% to the gallery.

8. The show will be juried with cash awards.





Students will experiment with the emotional effects of color to create calm, dynamic, or moody acrylic landscape through the explanation of color theory. We will explore techniques, including blending, dry brush, textural effects with mark making and transparency and opaqueness. Students will apply personal

expression of color, shapes and lines to achieve the emotional effect they wish to portray. Demonstrations of color mixing, composition and critiques will be an essential tool in this class. Students will initially work from black and white photographs and later depart from it to incorporate they own individual expression.
