Presidents Report

- President Joe Wolff displayed several important slides and videos appear on the website
 Wellingtonrc.com. Topics of interest include:
 - Trump Fireworks at the Bloomberg Forum
 - "Art of the Surge" video the story of the Donald Trump comeback.
 - "Polymarket Election Winners" Polymarket is the world's largest prediction market. It states that Donald Trump will win the 2024 presidential election by 63% over Harris's 33%. Other election predictions are also available on the website "Polymarkt.com".
 - A billboard advertising AMISH FOR TRUMP is seen on the roadside of Lancaster,
 PA. The irony here is that the Amish usually do not vote!
 - On October 20, 2024, Donald Trump visited a McDonald's restaurant in Feasterville-Trevose, PA, made French fries, and even distributed them through the drive-up window to surprised customers. The event was highly publicized. A letter from the United States Senate was sent to McDonalds Corp voicing their concern over the rising cost of fast food. The Senate asks McDonalds to explain their pricing decisions. That letter was dated October 21, 2024. Coincidence?
 - The Central Park Five sue Donald Trump for adds he ran in the New York Times during their trial. Their guilty verdicts have been overthrown, members were encouraged to watch their full confessions, conducted at the time of their arrests. Those confessions can be found on the club website under "more" & "Central Park Five"
 - Since Elon Musk endorsed Donald Trump and contributed funds to his campaign, Musk's companies are increasingly facing regulatory battles and federal investigations from all corners of the U.S. government.
 - Robert Kennedy, Jr., endorses Trump and wants to make America Healthy Again (MAHA).
 - Various charts are shown on the website demonstrating the differences between the Trump and the Biden administrations - stock market growth, prices of groceries, gasoline, mortgage rates, and personal income. There are also charts showing the rise in crime, criminal justice and incarcerations. The FBI has hidden a 55% rise in violent crime during the Biden/Haris administration.
 - Slide of Amendment 4 regarding the abortion issue and dollars spent to support or oppose the ballot initiative.
 - Reminder to vote early at any of the five area locations.
 - Slide from Facebook erroneously states that Mark Cioffi, school board candidate, supports Kamala Harris.
 - The New York Times runs the iconic picture of Trump after the assassination attempt in butler, PA but eliminates the words "Fight, Fight, Fight".
 - Trump comments on Mark Zuckerberg who has plotted against him.

each spoke for 4 minutes. Mark spoke about "the Anxious Generation" and the need for
