



Central Park Five sue Trump

Say his words regarding jogger beating were false

The men formerly known as the Central Park Five before they were exonerated on Monday filed a defamation lawsuit against Republican presidential nominee Donald Trump.

With election day two weeks away, the group accused the former president of making "false and defamatory statements" about them during last month's presidential debate with Vice President Kamala Harris. The group is asking for a jury trial to determine compensatory and punitive damages.

"Defendant Trump falsely stated that plaintiffs killed an individual and pled guilty to the crime. These statements are demonstrably false," the group

wrote in a federal complaint.

The men are upset because Trump essentially "defamed them in front of 67 million people, which has caused them to seek to clear their names all over again," co-lead counsel Shanin Specter told The Associated Press in an email.

Specter had no comment when asked if there were concerns some see the lawsuit as purely political because of the group's support for Harris.
"We are seeking redress in

the courts," Specter said.

Trump campaign officials did not immediately respond to emails seeking comment.

Yusef Salaam, Antron Mc-Cray, Kevin Richardson, Raymond Santana and Korey Wise were teenagers when they were accused of the 1989 rape and beating of a white woman jogger in New York City's Central Park. The five, who are Black and Latino, said they confessed to the crimes under duress. They later recanted, pleading not guilty in court and were later convicted after jury trials. Their convictions were vacated in 2002 after another person confessed to the crime.

After the crime, Trump purchased a full-page ad in The New York Times calling for the teens to be executed. The jogger case was Trump's first foray into tough-on-crime politics that preluded his full-

throated populist political persona. Since then, dog whistles and overtly racist rhetoric have been Trump fixtures.

In the Sept. 10 debate, Trump misstated key facts when Har. ris brought up the matter.

"They admitted, they said they pled guilty and I said, well, if they pled guilty they badly hurt a person, killed a person ultimately... And they pled guilty, then they pled not guilty," Trump said.

He appeared to be confusing guilty pleas with confessions. Also, no victim died.

The now Exonerated Five, including Salaam — who is now a New York City councilman — have been campaigning for Harris. Some of them spoke at the Democratic National Convention in August, calling out Trump for never apologizing for the newspaper ad.

They have also joined civil rights leader the Rev. Al Sharpton for a get-out-the-vote bus tour.








Inflation in the consumer price index


STOCK MARKET PERFORMANCE S&P 500 growth

GROCERIES Growth in prices of food at home






GAS PRICES

Average price of a gallon of regular gas






INTEREST RATES

Average rate on a 30-year, fixed-rate mortgage






SHELTER

Growth in shelter prices



Real per capita disposable income growth



Progressives undercut all legs of criminal justice. In the 1960s their anti-prison crusades crippled corrections and sent crime skyrocketing. It took 100s of laws to fix the damage. In 2014 progressives added their War on Police and then added their War on Courts with the Rogue Prosecutors Movement.




HOMICIDES & OUT OF WEDLOCK BIRTHS

15 to 25 year olds commit the most crimes. The red line is the out of wedlock rate, moved 20 years to the right. Thus it shows the percentage of 20 year olds born out of wedlock. Out of wedlock births had nothing to do with the crime explosion in the 1960s. Truth-In-Sentencing laws cut crime in half in 20 years, during which 20 years olds born out of wedlock more than doubled. Again the correlation is negative.



MASS INCARCERATION FICTION

'The Criminals Were Back on the Street Before the Police Could Fill Out the Paperwork'




Progressives demolished corrections in the 1960s with insane utopian ideology. Led by top judges and corrections reformers; they said criminals would simply be rehabilitated instead. Crime skyrocketed as incarcerations were slashed. Progressives refused to reverse course, even as crimes increased by hundreds of millions. It took a Truth-in-Sentencing Revolution to undo the damage; federal and state TiS laws; laws ending abuses in probation, parole, pre-trial detention and early release; three strikes; and crime assets seized.

HOMICIDES: 101 YEARS

Progressives triggered the biggest crime explosion ever in the 1960s with insane policies. The defeat of Democrats in 1995 corresponds with Truth-in-Sentencing laws that cut homicides back to 1950s levels. In 2014 progressives launched BLM and the defund the police movements.



Crime rates climbed higher in good economies and dropped lower during downturns. The supposed correlation of crime to unemployment or bad economies is false, historically over 101 years, strongly the opposite.
