## Trash and Discards Pick-Up Schedule

Pick-Up Day for trash, recyclables, yard waste, and bulk items is **THURSDAY**. Please wait till Wednesday after 5:00 pm to place items at the curb. Move empty containers out of view Thursday evening. Questions or problems? Call the City at (941) 365-7651

TRASH: The large green City trash cart is for trash only, not recyclables or yard waste.

RECYCLABLES: All recyclables go into the recycling cart (with the yellow lid).

- Empty and rinse all containers. NO loose caps and lids. **Recycle ONLY those items shown on the accompanying Recycling Flyer from the City. NO shredded paper, scrap metal, plastic bags or Styrofoam.**

YARD TRIMMINGS:

- Place into containers (45 gal or less / 50 pounds or less); or paper bags, or
- Tie into bundles no more than 4 feet in length, 50 pounds or less.
- Large quantities - place at curb as is. Call (941) 365-7651. Estimate will follow (\$38.03 per cubic yard). Upon your approval, will be added to your utility bill, and a special pickup will be scheduled.

BULK ITEMS:

- Furniture, appliances – a single item will be removed at no charge. Remove refrigerator doors.
- Construction waste – up to one cubic yard of waste from residential renovation free of charge. For larger quantity, estimate will be given (\$38.03 per cubic yard). Upon your approval, will be added to your utility bill and special pickup will be scheduled.
- Bundle and tie carpet.
- Electronic waste – TV's, computers, microwave ovens – place at curb. NOTE: printers are considered Hazardous Waste – see below.
- Tires – up to 4 passenger tires without rims.
- Used oil – place in clear plastic containers with screw-on lids. Place used oil filters in a clean zip-lock bag.

HAZARDOUS WASTE: Liquid paint, household or lawn chemicals, printers, phones, fluorescent bulbs, CFLs, car batteries, batteries for cordless phones, button batteries, rechargeable batteries. The City hosts special collections during the year where hazardous waste can be dropped off. Or you can take it to the Bee Ridge Rd Facility at 8750 Bee Ridge Rd. from 8 am to 4 pm, Wednesday thru Saturday. NOTE: Empty paint cans may be left open to dry, then put into the City trash cart.
