## This Underused, Evergreen Shrub Is a Winter Gem

*Paxistima canbyi* 'Mountain Lover' is a low-growing, evergreen shrub that offers beautiful texture all year long. In the winter, its glossy, dark-green leaves take on purple hues in full sun.

Native to North America's Allegheny Mountains, *Paxistima canbyi* Mountain Lover has proven to be very adaptable to the West. It tolerates clay soil, alkaline soil and drought. It can handle our fluctuating winter temps.

This shrub also thrives in tricky spots, growing well under deciduous trees or in the challenging (and often not-so-pretty) canopy drip line of spruces and pines. Ideal for full sun to part shade.
