Korean Feather Reed Grass Shines in the Fall!

Calamagrostis brachytricha puts on a show after many other plants have quit for the season. Large 12" plumes with a pink tinge come on in August and will turn to tan in late fall. Native to the moist woodlands of central and eastern Asia, this grass will thrive with moderate to low water, and in full sun or partial shade. Korean feather grass will tolerate heavy clay soil, which helps keep the roots moist in the arid western US. You can also plant it in loam and sandy soils, and it will grow up to 7500 feet. Cut this grass back every spring to make way for the new season's growth.
