KOKEDAMA CARE GUIDE



WATERING: Submerge the kokedama moss ball in water once or twice a week, depending on the plant's needs and the humidity of your environment. Allow the ball to soak for a few minutes until it feels heavy and saturated.

LIGHT: Most kokedama plants prefer bright, indirect light. Avoid direct sunlight as it can scorch the moss and affect the plant's health.

HUMIDITY: Kokedama plants appreciate high humidity levels. Mist the moss ball regularly, especially during dry periods or in heated indoor environments.

PRUNING: Trim back any yellowing or dead leaves to keep the plant looking tidy and to promote new growth.
