

KOKEDAMA SOIL MIX



Peat Moss Potting Soil

TWO PARTS

Peat moss is ideal for your kokedama soil mix as it both retains moisture well, and helps to balance and draw moisture from the natural clay. Available at most home and garden stores.



Sphagnum Moss

ONE PART

Adding sphagnum moss to your kokedama soil mixture is good both for moisture retention and to create pore spaces in the soil. Available at most home and garden stores.



Pure Clay Litter

ONE PART

Basic clay litter without added chemicals is a perfect binder for your kokedama ball. It is widely available at grocery stores. You may also use Japanese Akadama, but it is difficult to source



Perlite

A PINCH

Just a small toss of perlite can aerate the soil, and help your kokedama roots from getting too much moisture. Available at home and garden stores.



Sheet Moss

There are two common types of sheet moss that you can use. We prefer the unpreserved, as it is dormant, and can begin to grow after wetted. Available at home and craft stores.
