

Supportive Services for Veteran Families at the University of Vermont Program Participation Application & Agreement

The Supportive Services for Veteran Families (SSVF) program at UVM provides services to help veteran who are homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless. These services include intensive case management and housing counseling, and may include other optional services or referrals for services such as financial counseling, assistance accessing VA benefits, and others. SSVF program at UVM uses a Housing First approach, which means that gaining or retaining housing is not dependent on preconditions such as minimum income or sobriety.

SSVF program at UVM expects that all participants will engage fully in the program as described in the following statements.

In participating in the SSVF program, I agree to:

- Complete eligibility paperwork and submit all verification documentation required by SSVF
- Engage in a safe and respectful manner with my Housing Service Coordinator and all SSVF staff
- Answer all questions to the best of my ability
- Be an active participant and work collaboratively with my Housing Service Coordinator, other service provider staff, and landlord to gain/maintain housing
- Allow habitability checklist completion as a requirement of TFA assistance as needed
- Meet with my Housing Service Coordinator as requested
- Immediately inform my Housing Service Coordinator of any housing assistance I receive from other non-SSVF programs
- Provide accurate contact information
- Immediately inform my Housing Service Coordinator if I move out of the service area
- Immediately inform my Housing Service Coordinator of any housing assistance and/or offers of housing
- Request to speak to my Housing Service Coordinator's Supervisor with concerns
- Participate in feedback surveys at 45-60 days and at exit

I further understand that failure to comply with the above mentioned statements could result in the following:

- A meeting with members of the supportive services team to evaluate continued program eligibility;
- A halt in any/all SSVF services;
- A disqualification/termination of SSVF at UVM services

I agree with the terms and requirements to receive SSVF at UVM services. I also understand that providing false information may result in disqualification/termination from the program.

I understand that this is not an entitlement program. Decisions on participation are based on a review of information about a household, whether that household meets the criteria that are outlined in the federal program regulations, the availability of funds, and staff needed for participation.
