Social Distancing Procedures

At F.A.C.E.S. of Success the health and safety of our students and families is always our highest priority. To mitigate the risks of COVID-19 while children are in our care, we have adopted additional health and safety measures based on the recommended guidelines set forth by the Texas Education Agency (TEA), Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Texas Health and Human Services Commission (THHSC). Given the evolving situation, we will continue to update these protocols as necessary. Last updated 8/25/2020.

- 1. Health Checks:** Students will enter into grade level check points to be screened for temperatures and other symptoms. Staff will also be screened for symptoms before entry into the building daily. Anyone with a temperature of at least 100.4 degrees or showing other signs of illness will not be permitted to enter the program. If a student becomes ill during programming, they will stay in a separate area to limit exposure. Parents will be contacted for immediate pickup. Staff will be sent home if showing signs of illness.
- 2. Facial Coverings:** Staff members will wear facial coverings while interacting with students. Students will wear facial coverings at all times unless eating or drinking.
- 3. Safe Distancing:** Students will be grouped together with no more than 15 individuals per class and will remain with their group for the duration of programming. Seating areas will be spaced a minimum of 6 feet apart. No large group activities will be permitted. Activities will be planned to minimize interaction, yet keep students engaged and enjoying the program.
Staff members are the only adults permitted to enter the building. Pick up and drop off will take place outside the facility.
During transitions such as restroom breaks, change of activities and dismissal. Students will be spaced in single file lines 6 feet apart.
- 4. Sanitation:** Staff and children will practice handwashing in compliance with the CDC recommendations and hand sanitizer will be available in each class setting. On-going disinfecting of equipment will occur after each use. Thorough sanitization of desks, chairs, shared equipment & frequently touched surfaces will occur upon closing daily. Staff will wear disposable gloves for serving food and while sanitizing. Snacks will be served in individually wrapped, sealed packages.
