

Wild Camping Wiltshire Pet Policy

As responsible dog owners in the countryside we advise pet owners to adhere to the countryside code, don't stray from foot paths and be respectful of livestock and farming activities.

Dogs must be kept on a lead of no more than 2 metres at all times when outside on the campsite.

Dogs must not be permitted to roam free on the campsite.

All dog breeds listed under the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 are prohibited from Greener Camping Club campsites. Specifically this includes:

- a) Any dog of the type known as the pit bull terrier**
- b) Any dog of the type known as the Japanese tosa**
- c) Any dog of any type appearing to be bred for fighting, or to have the characteristics of a type bred for that purpose.**

Dog/pet poo should be bagged and binned.

If a dog/pet causes nuisance, eg. noise or uncontrolled behaviour, to any other campers for any reason and you are unable to resolve the issue with the dog owner, we will ask the owner to remove the dog/pet from the campsite, or ask the owner to leave the campsite.

Any refund of balance of fees relating to the remaining period of a stay is at our discretion.
