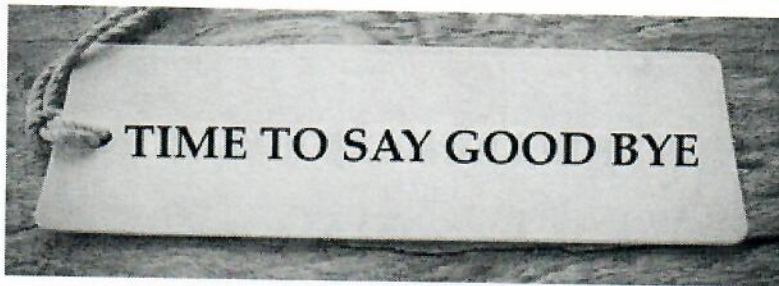
NOTE:

The Dressage Company Meeting Minutes

October 18, 2021

The Rusty Bucket in Liberty Township

The meeting was called to order at 7:21PM

Minutes were approved, although there was not an October Newsletter.

Membership report-no change since last meeting. Members were reminded that the new membership year begins in November. Due to our small size, we will not have a delegate or proxy vote at the USDF Convention. An update to the membership form was discussed, to advertise benefits of joining, and may be geared to those new to dressage and to those attending local shows.

Treasurer's report. We have a little over \$10,000 in our combined accounts. Exact numbers can be obtained from Carol Hartlaub.

Old Business:

Debbie Boeh spoke to Barb McCarthy at Majestic Farm about working together for a new test clinic for the eventing tests, which are about to change. This could be a co-sponsored event, with Debbie the teaching clinician, and MF's new eventing trainer as a demo rider. Dates are being discussed, and the club is welcome to pass out flyers at MF's upcoming horse shows. Barb indicated that she wants to grow along with TDC, and work together. Our club would like to gain access to MF's email lists so we can send clinic information to barns that send riders to their shows. A raffle or discount to entice new TDC members was discussed. It was also noted that currently, Majestic Farm/Barb/trainers are not TDC members, and this would be a good show of their support, if they would join. We discussed the possibility of a barn vs personal membership, as well as linking to us from MF's website, as they are linked from ours. The idea of getting TDC members embroidered jackets to wear at local shows, so people could seek out members with questions, and to raise awareness of our GMO was also discussed.

The need to plan our other 3 educational events for next year was also discussed, and will be addressed by the new board/committees.

Nominations and Elections-further nominations were obtained, and all positions were uncontested, so the new slate of officers was approved.

It was noted that long time member Trish Hammer has passed away. When funeral details are known, they will be passed along.

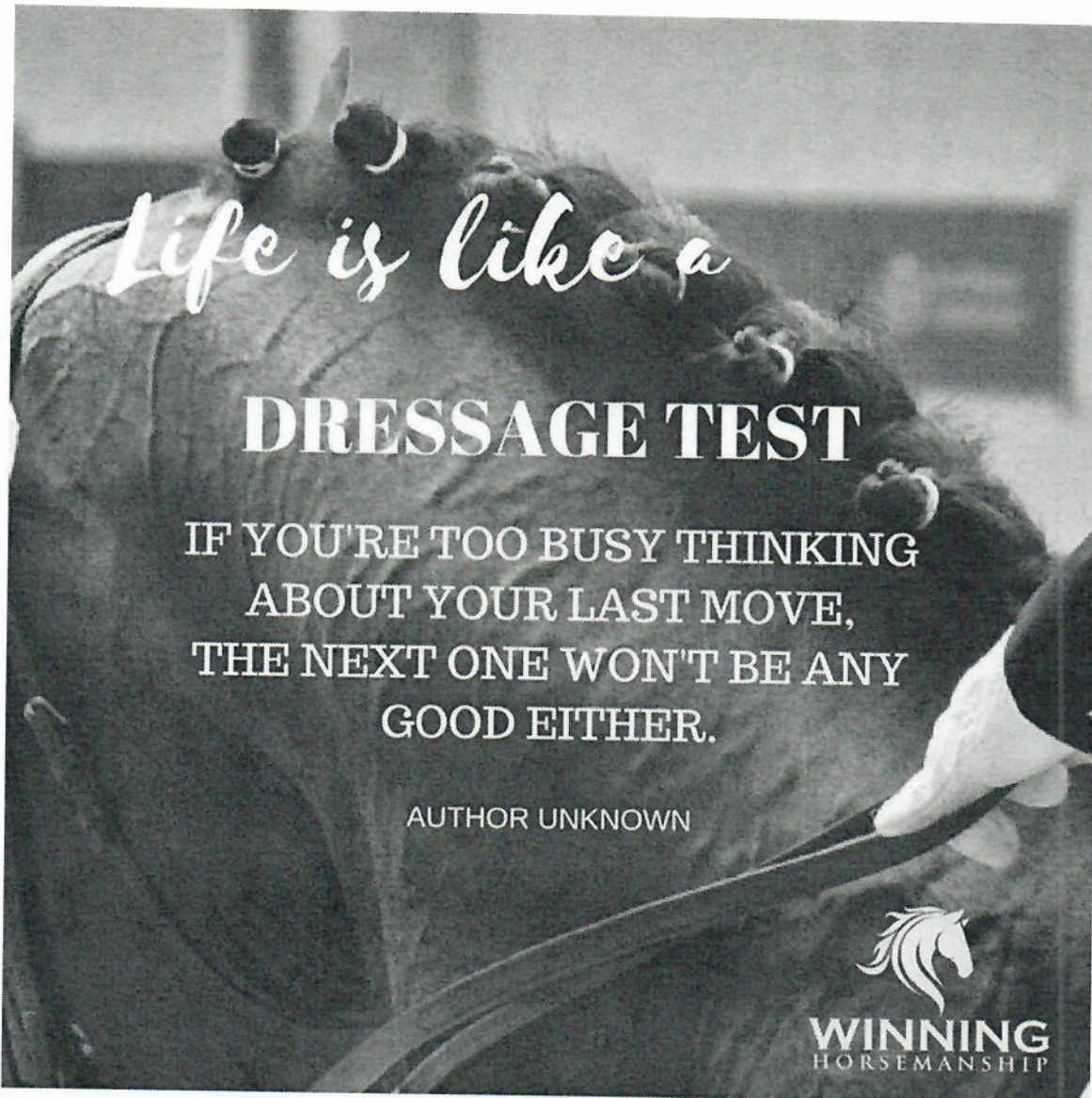
Next meeting is November 15, 2021. We will have a holiday dinner at a restaurant in December, where YEA winners can pick up their awards.
