HORSE TREAT RECIPE



1 1/4 cup steel cut oats

3/4 cup molasses (see note above)

1/2 cup flour

1/2 cup flaxseed

2 tsp cornstarch

1/4 cup water

1/4 cup Apple or pear scraps, processed (skins work well)

Mix molasses and oats, until oats are fully coated. gradually stir in flour, flaxseed and cornstarch until combined.

Add in scraps and water and stir to combine.

Grease muffin tin very, very, very well so you will not have to scrap out the muffins.

Fill muffin tins about 1/2 way

Bake at 350 degrees for app. 15-20 minutes - watch closely so they won't burn

Press in chrismas peppermint candy, if you wish, and then remove from tin immediately.


Put them in the fridge to cool and firm up.
