

The Dressage Company Meeting Minutes (February 17, 2020, Rusty Bucket)

Meeting called to order by President Sue McBeth at 7:04PM.

- A. Minutes from 1/20/20 Board and General meetings as published in the newsletter were approved.
- B. Reports:

Membership- we currently have 19 paid members Treasurer-no report until April

- C. Old Business
 - 1. Website update-Isi is still trying to find out from Nancy Nicholson's estate if there is any way to access the old site. Leslie Laine reported that the site is as close as possible to being finished at this point. The categories are as previously noted in the newsletter. She would like some members to look at the new site and make suggestions/offer comments. The site is currently at www.thedressagecompany.godaddysites.com. Leslie's email address for comments is Ldlaine@fuse.net. Leslie would also like members to email her some nice pictures with their horses, to replace some of the stock art that GoDaddy supplies. Please give Leslie feedback by 3/6/20. Leslie will be contacting GoDaddy support with some of her questions, and will let us know when the site is live for general use, and will also update search engines.
 - 2. Use of \$500 for scholarship or clinic participation-this was tabled for a future meeting
 - 3. Nancy Nicholson memorial award-Carol Hartlaub got information about trophies from CAM Awards, and shared these with the group. Prices varied from \$275-\$500, depending on size and shape. We looked at bowls and loving cups, and the group decided on a large loving cup, which would have a place on the base for the winner's names, as well as have engraved art and the name of the award on the cup. CAM can also provide smaller versions of the cup for individual winners. Carol is still looking into pins. The group decided to name the award the Nancy Nicholson Winner's Circle.
 - 4. Awards Dinner feedback-Carol Hartlaub and Sue McBeth met with Barb McCarthy about issues with the awards banquet, and the desire to no longer partner with Majestic Farm for this event, as it just became too long and impersonal. Majestic Farm is open to another co-sponsored event to bring the Cincinnati dressage community together, which might include a trainer's wine & cheese, or possible a Ride-A-Test clinic. It was pointed out that a clinic might have to be also held at Walnut Creek Stables, due to trying to cover a large portion of our area. The Dressage Company will hold our Year End banquet on 12/6/20 at Malloy's in Green Twp, combined with QCDC and Walnut Creek, as it has previously been done.

D. New Business

- 1. Ideas for educational events for 2020-Isi Brown stated that she feels that the club needs to examine our vision and decide how we want to grow our membership, and thinks we should consider 1-2 large events to draw a bigger crowd. She reread a lot of shows on everyone's calendars, and people's time is limited. Debbie Boeh brought up the fact that our area has had a "disconnect" with NKY and the area closer to Columbus due to requirements for a TD at shows, and stated these people don't come to QCDC shows any more. Carol stated the cost of a TD is often more than the judge. It was discussed that there needs to be a "perk" or value to joining that would set us apart from Pony Club or other organizations, and entice people to join TDC, for example discounted clinic rates.
 - Ideas for events on a larger scale included L judge's clinic, "Big Name" trainer clinic, social events like a Halloween fun event, or a multi-arena Training Day. The Training Day got a lot of support, and Carol offered to host the first one at Walnut Creek, perhaps this Fall. More details to come.
- 2. Next meetings-Isi is looking for a social event for our March meeting, like glass blowing, pottery painting, etc, and more information will be available soon. April's meeting will likely feature equine chiropractic and acupuncture to be held at Isi Brown's farm. May will be a business meeting at the Rusty Bucket to prepare for our show. Our show is the June meeting. More updates will be provided when available.
