No Fairfax Casino Coalition Hosts Lobby Day at the Virginia General Assembly

Fairfax, VA – The No Fairfax Casino Coalition, comprised of Fairfax County residents, civic leaders, and advocacy groups, will host a Lobby Day on February 12 at the Virginia General Assembly to voice strong opposition to Senate Bill 756, which aims to authorize a casino in Fairfax County along the Silver Line corridor.

Community members will travel to Richmond to meet with legislators and share their concerns about the potential effects of a casino within Fairfax County’s economic center. The coalition is united in its effort to protect the community and safeguard the interests of residents and local businesses.

“We are standing together to protect our community and ensure our voices are heard,” said Lynne Mulston, Chairperson of the No Fairfax Casino Coalition. “The proposed casino threatens the fabric of our larger community and prioritizes casino interests over the legislative process, local land use authority, and the well-being of our residents and businesses.”

A press conference will be held in conjunction with Lobby Day. All media representatives are encouraged to attend. The press conference will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the House Briefing Room (Room 209). Hosted by Delegate Holly Siebold, speakers will include state legislators opposing the bill and its process, and Vienna Town Mayor Linda Colbert.
