Emergency Care Plans

Carers often worry about what would happen to the person they care for if they were unable to provide care due to an accident or emergency, especially if that person struggles to communicate. Making an Emergency Care Plan allows you to have all of the important information in one easily accessible place. Carers Northumberland can help you to complete an Emergency Care Plan form that includes emergency contact and key holder information, medication lists, allergies and details of the person's care needs.

We upload a copy of the Emergency Care Plan to your record on our secure database and send several copies back to you. These should be kept somewhere safe, you might also want to provide copies to your emergency contacts, key holders, GP, social worker, care manager or other friends and family. The form can be updated when anything changes and we will provide new copies for you to distribute.

Other things to consider

ICE (In case of emergency) phone numbers:

Most smartphones have an option to have emergency contacts and medical information accessible even when the phone is locked. This will allow someone to make calls from the phone to the listed emergency contacts and find out more about medical conditions if needed.

iPhone – In the Apple Health app, complete the information ensuring that the "Show when locked" is switched on **Android** – Open settings, user account, emergency information and complete the information you wish to display when the lock screen is on.

Lasting Power of Attorney

Carers Northumberland can support carers and the people they look after to create Lasting Power of Attorneys, Advance Decisions (living wills) and Advance Statements. Our trained advisors will support you to understand all aspects of making and registering an LPA, help with all form filling, explains fees and the processes involved to make advance plans for the future

Assessments

Having a care needs and carers assessment can help to put additional plans in place to support the person you care for. This can also be helpful to plan "back up" care when you need it, arrange for respite and ensure that the person you care for is known to social services in the case of an emergency. These assessments are carried out by Northumberland Social Care, please contact us for more details.



Carefree - Breaks for Carers

Carefree offers hotel breaks for carers by partnering with hotels across the country to make use of unsold rooms.

Full-time (30+ hours per week) unpaid carers (18+) can gain access to Carefree's Breaks Hub by direct referral from Carers Northumberland.

There is a £33 admin fee to be paid by the carer.

The break is for the carer only - carers are welcome to take a companion but not the person they care for.

Breaks typically consist of 1-2 nights plus breakfast for two. You can book a break once per year with Carefree.
