What to do once you've registered your Lasting Power of Attorney



Once your LPAs are registered you need to show them to relevant people and organisations to make sure everything is in place in case your attorneys need to step in. We recommend showing your LPAs to your bank/building society, GP/health professionals, social worker/care manager and anyone else who may need to see it.

Certifying Copies

You can show these people your original LPA form or a certified copy in person. We advise against posting your original form as it may get lost.

You can confirm that a copy of your LPA is genuine by 'certifying' it if you're still able to make your own decisions. To do this write the following text on the bottom of every page of the copy: "I certify this is a true and complete copy of the corresponding page of the original lasting power of attorney." On the final page of the copy, you must also write: "I certify this is a true and complete copy of the lasting power of attorney."

You need to sign and date every page.

Access Codes

Alternatively, an access code can be given to any company that needs to see the LPA. You can create these here: https://www.gov.uk/use-lasting-power-of-attorney. The letter you received when your registered the LPA has information on how to set up an account.

An access code is 13 characters long and begins with the letter V. It can be used by the company to view and verify the LPA. Before giving the access code to the company, check that it is the correct LPA for what you intend to do (Health & Welfare or Property & Finance). When you have given them the access code, the company will use the "View an LPA" website to check information such as:

- The donor's details on the LPA match the details they hold e.g. their name, address and date of birth.
- You are an attorney on the LPA. They may also want to see your identification.
- How decisions can be made using the LPA (if there is more than one attorney).
- Whether the LPA is still valid and registered
 If they are satisfied with this information they will allow attorneys to make decisions for the donor, for example giving them access to their accounts.

This information is for people who have already made and registered a Lasting Power of Attorney, if you want information or support on how to make a Lasting Power of Attorney contact us on 01670 320025

Did you know you may be able to get help with your travel costs for your hospital appointments?

You may be able to claim back travel costs if:

- You/your partner receive certain benefits or are eligible for the NHS Low Income Scheme
- You have a referral for an appointment that a doctor or dentist has referred you to You can claim on the day at the following sites:
- -Alnwick Berwick -Blyth -Hexham -North Tyneside -Wansbeck
 If your appointment is at the Northumbria hospital in Cramlington, or you would prefer
 to claim after your appointment, there is a form to fill out.
