What's your role in a nutshell?

I am a Carers into Work Advisor. I support carers to achieve their own personal goals. For some carers who want to move into work, I might update their CV, help them to apply for jobs or prepare for interviews.

What is the best part of the job?

I enjoy meeting the carers and seeing the progress they make to achieve their goals whether that be increasing confidence or accessing training.

Have you been a carer before?

Caring can be tough, and its really important that you take care of yourself. This workshop will help provide you with the tools to help manage your feelings of stress and understand how valued you are.


