This month we have updates on how our Info Team can support you and information about the Household Support Fund - a grant to help carers struggling with the essentials.

Whether you are looking to get organised in 2024 or just learn to take some time for yourself we have some great workshops coming up. Our Emergency Care Planning workshop will help you with practical future planning and our Carer Wellbeing workshop will feature a mindfulness and meditation session.

The nights are getting lighter and we've got lots of events and activities planned, including cinema club, catch up meals and walks. Make sure you book your place early to avoid disappointment!

Carers Northumberland are here to support you in your caring role, provide you with information and advice, help you access services, know your rights and help you take a break if you need one.

Our Information Line offers a single point of contact for any enquiry linked to your caring responsibilities. Our team can answer your questions, provide information on local services, financial matters, accessing social care and carer rights.

Benefit Checks & Grants

Our team can complete a benefit calculation to check that you are claiming all the benefits you are eligible for. This can be done over the phone and only takes around 20 minutes. We can also support you to access grants where appropriate.

Form Filling

Our team can support with filling in forms including Attendance Allowance, Carers Allowance, blue badges and council tax reduction forms. We are not currently able to support with PIP or DLA forms.

Emergency Care Planning

Our team can support you to make an Emergency Care Plan to document important information about the person you care for. Planning in advance for emergencies can give you peace of mind that the person you care for will be looked after and that all of their important information is in one easily accessible document.

Advance Planning

We are able to support carers and the people they look after to create Lasting Power of Attorneys (LPAs), Advance Decisions and Advance Statements. Our trained advisors will support you to understand all aspects of making and registering an LPA, help with all form filling, explain fees and the processes involved to make advance plans for the future.

Household Support Fund

We are working with Northumberland County Council to provide support to carers who are struggling with the cost of living. The grant is funded by the UK Government via the DWP. The grant is for support with costs of energy (heating, lighting, and cooking), food, water and other essential living needs (white goods etc.) The grant can cover only essential needs and cannot fund items that have already been purchased.

In order to access the fund the carer must have a benefit check to show they are claiming all benefits they are entitled to, must not have over £4000 in savings and must be classed as a low income household.

Take a break, enjoy a meal and meet other carers in a relaxed setting. Carers will be responsible for paying for their own meals. Booking is essential.




CARERS INTO WORK PROJECT

Sim Cards For Carers

Carers Northumberland have been supported by Vodafone's Charities Connected programme to provide free SIM cards to registered carers. The SIM cards have 20GB data, unlimited calls and texts per month, for 6 months. The SIM cards can only be used in Vodafone or unlocked handsets.
