Family Support Services


Provided families with over 435,000 referrals to child care businesses in all 351 cities and towns.




Each referral is customized to meet the needs of the families and their children.

Center-based care options have traditionally been the largest provider of full time care in MA with these programs making up 52% of the states' available full time capacity.




2024 Average Monthly Caseloads by Region






MACCR&R 2024 Child Care Data Report

Caseloads have surged in FY25 by over 7,300 children



CCR&R's have played a crucial role in managing the growing demand for child care financial assistance in Massachusetts. In 2022, CCR&R's administered child care financial assistance for over **28,000** children, by 'FY' 2025, that number had nearly doubled to over **48,000**.


