OBJECTIVE

Help your child design a device to hold and protect a graham cracker from breaking when dropped from 2 stories above!

MATERIALS

Use items you have around the house - empty paper towel rolls, straws, empty milk or egg cartons, rubber bands, popsicle sticks, bubble wrap, styrofoam, cups, tissue paper, etc.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Student can easily carry device on their own.
2. Student & teacher's names are written on the device.
3. Holds the graham cracker square that is approx. 2.5"x2.5"x0.25", with easy placement & removal.
