

ONE-ACCORD COMMUNITY PRAYER GATHERING

As you come in – quiet your mind and ask the Lord to help you rid yourself from all the noise and worries that may be going through your mind. When you're ready join in worship!

OUR OBJECTIVE: To gather and pray in **One-Accord** as the early church did (Acts 1:14). To increase in our faith and reliance upon the Lord through corporate prayer and supplication. Our goal is to tune our ear and heart to Holy Spirit's voice individually and as a group allowing Him to move us according to His will for our growth in love, edification, encouragement, healing, etc. We seek to be equipped and empowered to go out and walk/live according to the calling He has for each believer day to day motivated by the love of Christ.

Key points about our time together:

- Come with a **humble attitude and heart**. Everyone plays a key role in this.
- Be sure to write down any word(s) or scriptures that Holy Spirit reveals to you for someone or for the group.
- We **respect, love** one another, so all of our interactions are done with this in mind.
- We eagerly desire **ALL** gifts of the Spirit for the purpose of **edification and exhortation** of the body of Christ. **This is a safe place to practice this!**
- We will be in **expectation** when we pray. We will be **patient** allowing Holy Spirit to guide this gathering, so we'll strive to leave margin for Him to move.
- We will pray various ways - scripture, worship, stillness, (different topics, ie. our church, our city, marriages, education, leaders, praying as a corporate group, praying in small groups, praying through confessions, praying for healing, pray for each other, etc.)
- Include children if they can sit and listen – They learn most from us!
- **VERY IMPORTANT:** Please note that we will **not** discuss theology/doctrine here; however, if you have questions, we encourage you to reach out to your lead pastor for guidance. Please remember that this is a **safe and grace-filled** platform for everyone. Please know that in order to maintain this safe environment, anyone who is not able to follow our request in abstaining from these types of discussions, or is speaking with judgement towards others, will be asked to leave the prayer gathering.
- There will be moments when everyone will be muted a, mainly for the purpose to follow guided prayer, to prevent distractions and for you to focus on listening to what Holy Spirit is speaking. We will moments to open the lines for people to speak up in prayer for the group. Please be courteous if someone else is praying and wait for a moment to jump in.

SOME NOTES ABOUT EXERCISING THE GIFT OF PROPHECY...

Prophecy is meant to edify the body of Christ.

Scripturally, everyone is to operate in the spirit of prophesy. Everyone should seek the prophetic. God has called everyone to prophesy. 1 Corinthians 14:3-5, 12

Speaker = strengthened because your ear is getting more attuned/sensitive to Holy Spirit

Receiver = encouraged, comforted or strengthened

We rebuke the spirit that says anyone is unworthy to operate in the prophetic. We all are, but we need to practice listening and flowing with Holy Spirit.

When we receive a word/message:

- (1) **When you receive** a Scripture, Vision, Image, Picture, Word(s), Dream, could be physical feeling (Knee example)
The manifestation will be different. God made us unique and therefore we will uniquely operate in the prophetic. If you trying to mimic someone, you are not operating in the Holy Spirit.
- (2) **Ask the Holy Spirit:** What does this mean? You may not always be given the interpretation. 1) Revelation 2) Interpretation 3) Application (prophetic word requires obedience from both the speaker and the receiver)
*When do you want me to share it? (it is ok to hold or sit on a revelation)
*How do you want me to share it? (spoken or written)
- (3) **Test the message** (1 Corinthians 14:29-31) when you are a speaker or receiver (1 Thessalonians 5:21-22)
 - a. Does it align with the Bible (must know the Word of God)?
 - b. 2-3 other prophets (particularly necessary for words of correction or ministry vision). 2 Corinthians 13:1 state that "In the mouth of two or three witnesses shall every word be established." Please refrain from sharing these types of words in the gathering.
- (4) **When you share the message**
 - a. Share with love (Ephesians 4:15-16)
 - b. Pray with them
 - c. Encourage them to pray about it and ask for confirmation/revelation
 - d. Avoid sharing detailed life-changing words such as: dates, weddings, deaths, babies, moves, job changes, etc. These require more testing. If you need help testing these things, we're happy to help one-on-one or connect you with a group that can help you grow in the prophetic.

Tips for guided-prayer time and listening time:

- Start with silence and take a deep breath
- Consider being aware if Holy Spirit spotlights someone on the gathering, or reveals that you need to be quiet, or to pass the prayer baton to someone else.
- Keep the Bible close
- Keep a notepad when praying...to quickly jot down what comes to you
- Just do it! Don't take yourself too seriously...there is grace and it is not about you

Particularly in this prayer gathering there will be **EXTRA GRACE** ...so if you are not sure still share/pray. "Understand that when we pray for people or events, our spirit will become sensitized to receive more of God's prophetic impressions for these people or events."
