GENERAL JOB DESCRIPTION The Greeter will be positioned near the front entrance to welcome all individuals who come in with respect and a friendly, cheerful demeanor. The Volunteer will assist everyone who enters with registering their visit on the computer. This is to provide an accurate record of who (and how many) come it looking for assistance. Over time you will be expected to welcome each returning visitor by their first name.

- 3. Mandatory activities: All volunteers must attend two volunteer meetings a year. These meetings serve as a means of communication between Harmony House administration and staff and volunteers. We will discuss any new policies, procedures, events, and any other matters of interest to ensure that all members of Harmony House Inc. community are aware of what is going on.
