# **Appointments to the Trustee Board**



Following good practice recommendations from the Charity Governance Code, POR states Trustee Boards should have a minimum of 5, and no more than 12, Trustees in total. This includes ex officio and co-opted Trustees.

1st Little Paxton Scout Group Scout Council must agree the number of people to be appointed to the Trustee Board. The outgoing Trustee Board recommends that people are appointed. I propose the Group Scout Council approves that recommendation.

# Quorum for Future Meetings of the Trustee Board.



1st Little Paxton Scout Group Scout Council must agree its quorum – the minimum number of Group Scout Council members that must be present at Group Scout Council meetings. The outgoing Trustee Board recommends the quorum should be set at 5 people. Does the Group Scout Council approve that recommendation?

The quorum should consist of a minimum of 5 people with a balance from all section teams in the group.
