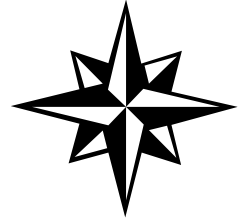

## *From Mother Kelly*

Epiphany Beloveds,

I hope you had a great Christmas and will have a great year! I am so proud of what we have accomplished this year!

As we start this New Year, on behalf of the Vestry, I would like you to consider your stewardship. Every Sunday at the offering, I say:  
"Walk in love, as Christ loved us and gave himself for us, an offering and sacrifice to God." *Ephesians 5:2*

This means two things. The first and most important is ourselves. We offer ourselves to God and recommit to Walk in love, as Christ loved us. The Eucharist is a communal exercise, and you are a valuable part of it. So the offering is reaffirming our commitment. Moreover, we

are called to discern whether we should take a leadership role in the church, whether that be Vestry member, Altar Guild, Choir, signing up for coffee hour, etc. God wants you to share your gifts of time and talent with us. There will be three openings on the Vestry. Please consider filling one of those spots.

Second, but not least, is our tithe. Giving is an integral part of a faithful and joyful Christian life, just as the Offertory is an essential aspect of the Eucharistic Action. Simply, the church has financial obligations every month, and we are not getting enough to cover our monthly expenses. In January, there will be pledge sheets available in the back of the church. Please consider filling that out as the Vestry prepares this year's budget for the annual meeting on Sunday, Jan 25th.

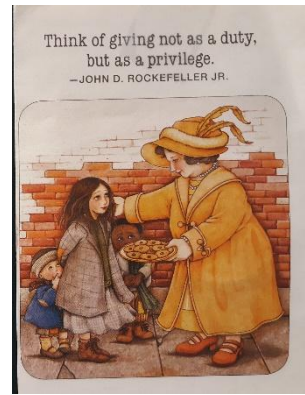
The Blessing of the Chalk – Sunday, January 4, 2026

- What the chalked letters on the door mean:
 - The 3 letters are the first Initial of each of the kings (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar).
 - The C, M, B also stands for the Latin blessing *Christus Mansionem Benedicat* which means “May Christ Bless this House”.
