-Blessing of the Chalk – Sunday, January 1, 2023

20 + C + M + B + 23

- Here's what the chalked letters on the door mean:
 - o The 3 letters are the first Initial of each of the kings (Caspar, Melchior, and Balthasar).
 - The C, M, B also stands for the Latin blessing Christius Mansionem Benedicat which means "May Christ Bless this House".
- The Christian custom of chalking the door has a biblical precedent as the Israelites in the Old Testament marked their doors in order to be saved from death. Families also perform this act to represent the hospitality of the Holy Family to the Magi (and all Gentiles); it thus serves as a house blessing to invite the presence of God in one's home.



January 2023 Backpack Ministry Update

Right before Christmas Break at Ford Elementary School, the guidance counselor handed me several Christmas Card thank-you's. I have attached a scanned copy of the inside of the Christmas cards to this update (not all would copy for this newsletter, but some are on the following two pages!.

As most of you are probably aware, Atonement Lutheran has closed because of the decline in membership. Atonement Lutheran actually began the Backpack program in 2012. That leaves the parishioners in 3 churches funding the Backpack Ministry. Because the price of food items has increased significantly, and it doesn't appear that the price will drop in the near future, we are seeking another church to join in this ministry at Ford Elementary School. We have been fortunate in receiving grant funding for milk, but that is only 1 item of 10 items included weekly for the 60 food insecure students. These are the most needy food insecure students of many needy students at Ford. As always, please contact Connie Daniels if you have any questions, comments or suggestions for the Backpack Ministry. We meet in the basement of First Methodist on Thursday mornings at 9 a.m. to pack the backpacks and deliver them to Ford Elementary. Come join us if you wish.
