What is Rowing for BRC Like?

- Commitment to teamwork and cooperation on boats of 4 or 8 + coxswain
- Row / Compete in the Spring; Fall/Winter Conditioning on land
- Spring Practices are at Beaverdam Reservoir boathouse, <u>after</u> school hours
- Winter conditioning combines erg training, running, and strength training
- Athletes are eligible for Varsity Letters and recognition through BRHS
- Regattas are run by the Virginia Scholastic Rowing Association (VASRA) and are held at Sandy Run on the Occoquan River (FFX)
- Yes, the blisters are real but so is the FUN!
