

What NOT to do:

- Think you're not good enough
- Wait until the last minute
- Fill out questionnaires and hope you get a response
- Have outdated statistics on your profiles
- Contact places others have gone to
- Contact schools that you wouldn't attend
- Text/email coaches casually

What to do:

- Take advantage of all opportunities
- Ask for help
- Start early (before end of 11th grade)
- Have your elevator pitch
- Fill out recruiting questionnaires and follow up
- Create an NCSA profile/instagram page
- Research schools that are the best fit for you (academics, location, quality of athletics)
- Communicate professionally (emails, texts, etc)

What should I expect as a BRC Parent?

- You are part of the team too!
- Commitment / support getting your rower to / from practices and regattas
 - Carpool Interest Sheet is available to help find others with the same interest
- Plan to volunteer
 - Many opportunities to be involved
 - Volunteering at VASRA Regattas has it's perks Park on-site for free!
- Be flexible
 - Regatta schedules are determined weekly, sometimes not being finalized until Friday before
 - Regattas are full days
- Cheer Loud!
 - Meet other BRC families at the Grand Stand and cheer on the team together!
