General Information

Jazz Band is a year course. Jazz Band is available only to students who play saxophone, trumpet, trombone, euphonium, piano, drum set, guitar or bass guitar. Other instruments are allow by a case by case basis. Jazz Band meets during the school day.

As this is a smaller ensemble, Jazz band members are held to a higher level of performance, participation and behavior. Students who are in other performing groups, are expected to practice all music from all participating bands/choirs and are subject to removal from the group if they are not. The focus is to introduce students to the basic techniques of the jazz including jazz music theory / history and how jazz history and composition relates to students' current life and musical experiences. The Jazz Band will perform at school assemblies; evening concerts, possibly a local festival, and it is also available to perform short concerts in our community.
