Please Review Your Insurance!

We are all sad for our Boulder County neighbors that lost their homes in the horrible fire. An article in the January 8, 2022 Wall Street Journal titled *Colorado Victims' Costs Top Some Coverage* stated that "Rising construction costs will push the price tag for rebuilding after Colorado's most destructive wildfire beyond the insurance coverage of some homeowners". **Please review your homeowner's insurance to be sure that you are adequately covered.** The following information is repeated from What's Up #59.

Article 8 of the Somerset Estates Declaration covers insurance requirements for both SEHOA and homeowners. Homeowners have the responsibility to obtain insurance in an amount not less than full replacement value of the Improvements on their Lot, less deductibles (excluding land). Homeowners are encouraged to check with their insurer that their policy covers these Improvements, including fences not located along

Somerset Drive and Longview Drive, for insurable events (wind/hail/fire/theft/vandalism). Maintenance related to normal wear and tear is not usually covered by insurance and responsibility is as described in the Lot Easement Policy (click here to read the Policy).

Additional Dog Waste Stations

We now have two dog waste stations installed in Somerset Estates with one more on its way! The first is near the start of the repaved path going from Longview Dr to Primrose Ln. The second is on the fence next to the Longview Dr sidewalk near the furthest east Cattail Dr street monument (see photos below). Thank you to Anthony and Wendy Chirikos for volunteering to "host" this station on their lot easement. The third will be installed soon at the start of the open space trail on the west side of Somerset Drive. These stations are emptied and sanitized weekly by Duty-Free Pets, which also restocks the waste bags. Please get in the habit of using one of the stations so that we have no more poop bags left around our beautiful neighborhood!
