ACC Neighborhood Walk On-Going

The Architectural Control Committee (ACC) has been walking through the neighborhood with the goal of checking the appearance of the community. **The maintenance standards can be found in Section V of the Architectural and Landscaping Standards, available by clicking here.** Any exceptions to the Standards visible from the roads or public paths will be communicated to the homeowner. The ACC appreciates your cooperation to quickly correct any items noted in this courtesy email. Please keep in mind that these are all volunteers that want the best for our neighborhood.

A few reminders:

This has been a wet year with lots of weeds and volunteer plants! Please remove any that are visible to a passer-by, including shoots that spring up from existing (or stumped) trees.

If you have a street monument on your lot with landscaping besides basic rocks or grass, **it is your responsibility to remove weeds and keep the plants lower than the bottom of the street name**. For all monuments, the homeowner must prune trees that are behind it so that branches don't touch the monument.

Please **remove trees and shrubs off all lateral fence boards** and clear all vegetation back a foot from all the fences around your lot, including fences next to access paths to the open space, along the open space, and between lots. This both prolongs the life of the fences and facilitates maintenance and staining.

Dead trees and bushes must be removed and either de-stumped (preferable) or cut so the stump is less than 6" above ground. Approval is **not required** to remove any vegetation or trees.

Street Monument Tuckpointing in Progress

You may have noticed a crew working on our street monuments and the pillars in the fence along Longview Drive. They are repairing mortar joints, reattaching the top stones that have become loose, and cleaning the fronts of the monuments. The electrical components on the backs of the monuments were repaired and/or replaced last year. The last step is to repair the stucco on the backside.

Xeriscaping Along Somerset Drive

SEHOA maintains the road rights-of-way along Somerset Drive and Longview Drive, even though these are technically owned by Boulder County. Most of the rights-of-way are grass irrigated by ditch water. Two areas on the south and west facing side of Somerset Drive are being converted to a mixture of grass and landscape rocks because the sun exposure, extensive tree roots, overhanging acidic spruce trees, and underlying sandstone make grass impractical and a waste of water. Sprinklers are being moved as part of the project.
