Proposed Revisions to the SEHOA Collection Policy

The Board updated most of its policies last year as a result of changes that the Colorado Legislature made to the Colorado Common Interest Owners Act (CCIOA). Our property management company, Trio Property Management, uses AppFolio software for billing and accounting. Because we assess dues quarterly, certain functions, such as adding a late fee for overdue accounts, can only be done automatically once a quarter, not every month as specified in the current SEHOA Collection Policy. The Board has reviewed the Policy with Trio and is proposing to adopt some relatively minor changes to make it easier to implement and to reduce the number of manual entries to account statements.

Street Monument Repairs Update

We are almost finished with a two-year project to repair the 27 street monuments. The electrical components on the backs of the monuments were repaired and/or replaced last year. Over the summer, we repaired mortar joints, reattached the top stones that have become loose, and cleaned the fronts of the monuments. This fall, we repaired the stucco on the back sides to prevent water damage to the monuments. Please see before and after photos below. 

Fence Along Pathway Repaired

The fence on the north side of the pathway from Longview Dr toward the end of Primrose Ln was damaged by a driving accident originating in the adjacent Autumn Ridge lot; this has been repaired at that homeowner's expense. In addition, several of the fence posts needed to be replaced or repaired along the length of the fence. This work is complete, including staining the fence.



Parking and Portable Toilets for Construction Projects

Also, the Architectural and Landscaping Standards address portable toilets as follows: "Portable toilets or similar temporary toilet facilities should not be on the road and shall be located only in areas approved by the ACC".
