What's Happening with the Public Improvement District (PID) for Roads?


The petition to create a Public Improvement District (PID) for the purpose of repairing and maintaining the roads in Niwot (other than the few that Boulder County will maintain) by seeking voter approval for a 12 mills additional property tax was withdrawn by the petitions after community input. The petitioners are working on a new version. The SEHOA executive board appointed Steve Lehan, Melissa Koller and Paula Hemenway to monitor developments. A group including these three SEHOA residents is also investigating the option to incorporate Niwot as a way to better serve Niwot residents in the on-going issues with Boulder County.
