Local Cloud Spotting

Somerset Estates is situated 5,300 feet above sea level just a few miles east of the Rockies. As a result, we often have the opportunity to see beautiful clouds. Clouds come in a wide variety. Some appear frequently, others more rarely. We were recently treated to especially beautiful skies during the ten days between June 14th and 24th.

Perhaps the most common are 'cumulus' clouds over the foothills. These often form early in the day by warmth from the rising sun hitting the front range, warming the air and causing it to rise and cool at higher altitude. **This rising air condenses and forms the puffy white cumulus clouds like the ones seen June 20th.** These clouds appear throughout the spring, summer and fall.

Because of our location adjacent to high mountains, we occasionally witness more unusual phenomena. For example, light from the setting sun is sometimes partially blocked by the Continental Divide or thunderstorms to the west. On June 14th, a powerful thunderstorm grew to 56,000 feet over Granby. Although 35 miles west, the tops of these towering clouds cast dramatic shadows producing picture perfect "crepuscular rays" or "God rays" visible from Somerset Estates.

On very rare occasions, crepuscular rays from the west illuminate mist and high clouds to the east. These "anti-crepuscular rays" are seen with the sun at your back. Nature gave us the remarkable display of this unusual phenomenon on June 19th.

Our ideal location also means we have the opportunity to witness some of the strangest and most awe inspiring clouds. "Lenticular" clouds are named for their lens shape and form downwind of large mountain ranges when high speed wind undulates up and down creating waves in the upper atmosphere. Air flowing over the Rockies can create these oddities of the sky and we are in the perfect place to see the resulting cloud formations. Lenticular clouds formed over Somerset Estates on June 24th. They can occur day or night, but are especially memorable at sunset.

Aside from creating lenticular clouds, **mountain waves can also affect aircraft**. Next time you are at cruising altitude on a commercial airplane and notice the engines periodically surging and falling quiet, look out the window. If you see these unusual clouds, you are hearing the engines keep the plane at a fixed altitude by alternately increasing power (loud) in downdrafts and decreasing power (quiet) in updrafts.

By staying in powerful mountain wave updrafts, **two pilots recently flew an unpowered glider above 76,000 feet**, a truly amazing feat.

We are truly fortunate to live in an area that affords us such beautiful sky views!
