Ultraknife has opened acts for many solid names in the industry like Headless Horseman, Makaton, Rrose and Luis Flores, among others.

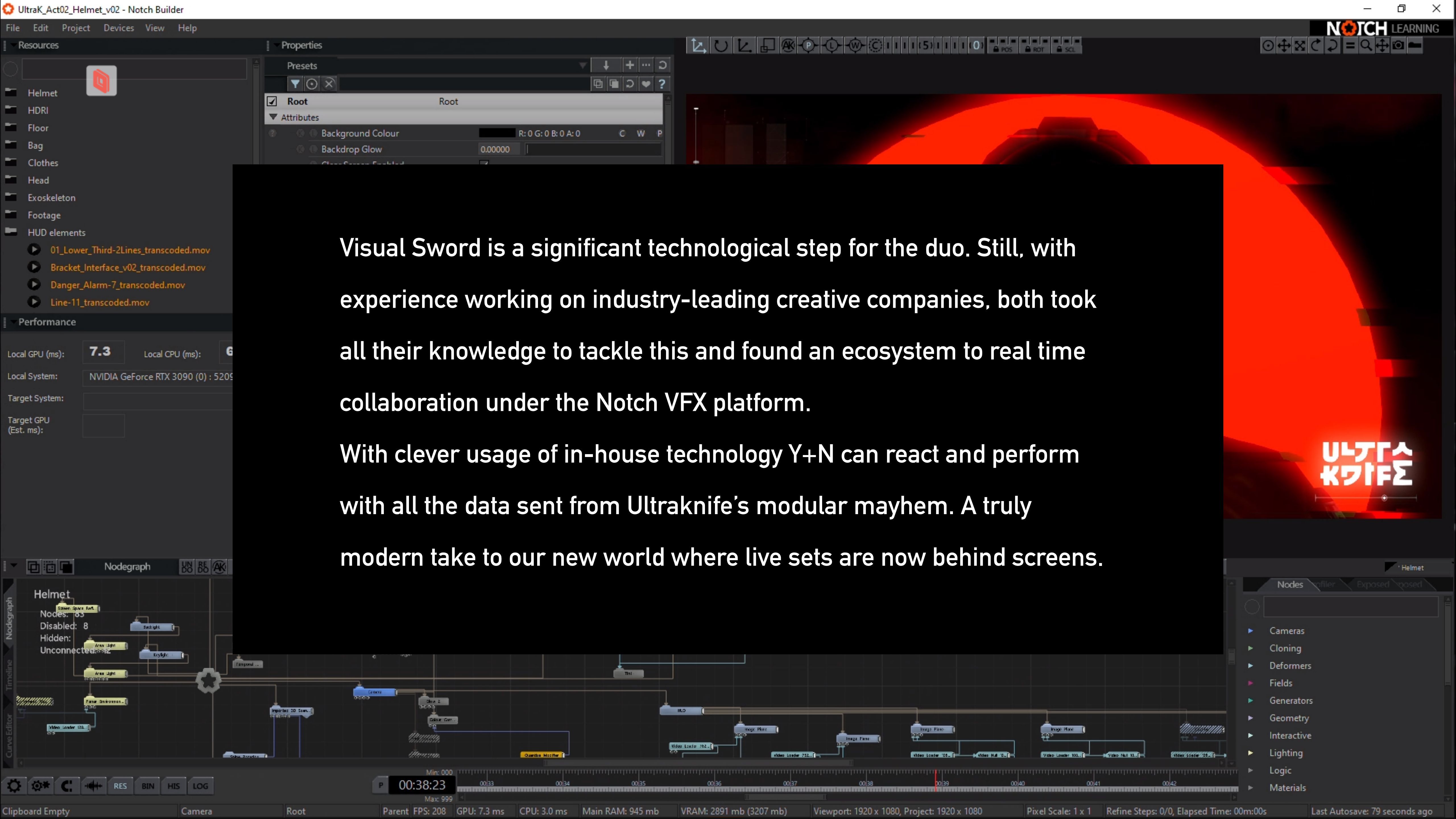

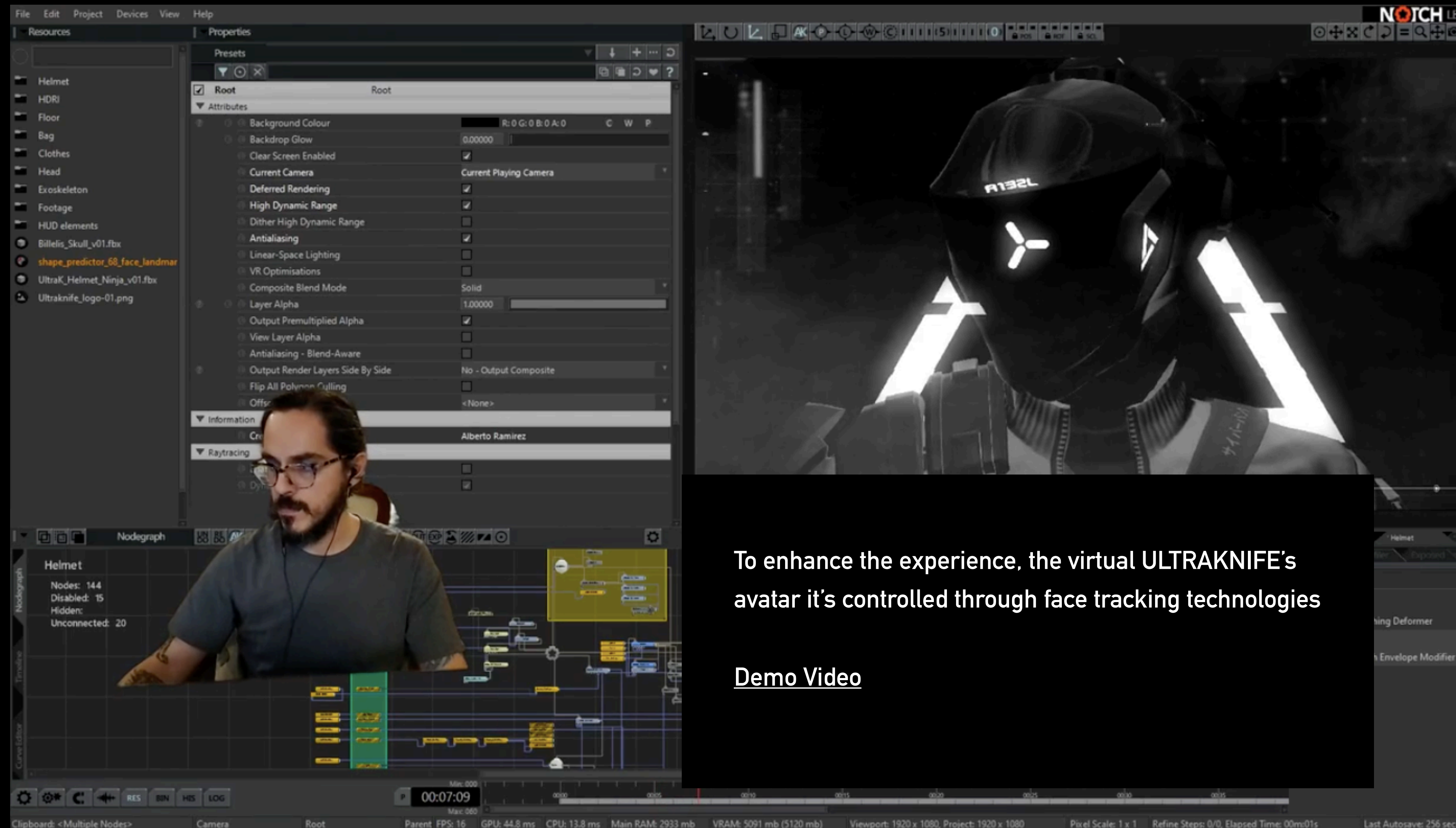
