Local Union 602 Scholarship Program

Purpose of Program

Under the direction of the LU 602, the goal of this program is to encourage apprentices to become more involved with L.U. 602 activities. Apprentices that complete the required activities during the current school year will have their books and tuition monies for that current school year reimbursed.

Eligibility

To participate in the program, each Participant:

- 1. Must be registered with the L.U. 602 Scholarship Program for the current school year
- 2. Must be enrolled in the WTXJATC
- 3. Must be a "Member in good standing" with I.B.E.W. L.U. 602
- 4. No reimbursements will be made if the participant withdraws from the WTXJATC on his/her own accord or is dropped by the WTXJATC Committee during the current school year.

Requirements

Each participant is required to:

- 1. This registration form <u>must</u> be completed and turned into the L.U. Scholarship Committee before any activities will be counted.
- 2. Be a member in good standing and remain current on all monthly dues to L.U. 602 for the duration of each current school year
- 3. Be a member in good standing and remain current with no more than 3 Death Benefits in arrears payable to L.U. 602 for each current school year
- 4. Attend 6 regular monthly Union meeting during the current school year
- 5. Meet all requirements for advancement in the apprenticeship program
- 6. Complete 4 elective activities.

Elective Activities

Elective activities include:

- 1. Participate as committee member (must be appointed by President of LU 602 to specific committee's)
- 2. Participate LU activities
 - (e.g. L.U. 602 Picnic, Habitat for Humanity, A.F.L.-C.I.O., neighborhood walks, political rallies, etc.)
- 3. L.U. 602 Education Classes
 - (e.g. Steward Training, Voter Registration, Code of Excellence, OSHA 10, CPR)
- 4. Assist with record keeping for the Scholarship Program
- 5. Referring a new member to L.U. 602.
- 6. Any other activities must be approved by L.U. Scholarship Committe

Reimbursement Awards

Beginning with the August union meeting, awards will be presented to those who complete the required activities. In order for a candidate to be eligible to receive an award at the regular union meeting all activities <u>must</u> be completed before the last day of the previous month (e.g., candidates who complete all activities prior to May 31st will receive awards on or after the night of the June meeting).
