DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Old English Sheepdogs that are six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration or Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Puppies under four (4) months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds

Entries must be submitted on Official AKC-form with correct entry-fees listed. One dog per form.

NO emailed forms, fax or telephone entries accepted.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. **Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$30.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.** Be sure to include correct fees. Overpayments less than \$10 will not be refunded

BIS, AND INJURY REFUND INFORMATION

Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee. Documentation from veterinarian is NOT required. If your bitch comes into season during the trial, please advise the trial secretary and any subsequent runs will be refunded in full.

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be refunded the entry fee, less \$8.00 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification with documentation from veterinarian must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on Friday September 25, 2026. Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian. Requests from chiropractors, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted. Handler illness/injury is excluded from this policy.

SITE & TRIAL INFORMATION

No Exhibitor Setup prior to Sunday Morning.

~Site opens daily at 8:00am. Judging will begin at 9:00am.

~Crating space is available inside Building 17 (to the right and connected to the trial ring building)

~Exhibitors are asked to place a waterproof tarp or similar material under all crates on the blue matting

~Crates may be left in the building overnight between trial days, but MDTC and OESCA will not be responsible for damage or theft of any exhibitor's property

-Please potty your dogs only on MDTC property, not on neighboring properties

~Exhibitors are asked to clean up after their dogs

~A warm up jump will be available in the crating area

~Course maps will be emailed out Sunday morning and posted on site

~Eating/Drinking is allowed in Building 17 (crating area) but NOT in the trial ring side of the building

~Site is climate controlled
