Participants are not required to complete ACT 1 or ACT 1J before completing ACT 2 or ACT 2J, although titling in ACT 2 or ACT 2J prohibits participants from competing in ACT 1 or ACT 1J; ACT and ACT Jumpers operate separately (you can compete in ACT 1 and ACT 2J at the same time, or vice versa).

Handlers will be permitted to walk the course, without the dog, during a walk-through period held before the start of the class.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older may enter a test. Dogs must be physically sound as described in Chapter 1, Section 3, Paragraph 7 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. In order to acquire the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC. Canine Partner applications may be accepted at the test by the judge/evaluator and submitted with test results. Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. This temporary recording number will be e-mailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events and when the owner registers/lists the dog. Note: Temporary recording numbers may only be used to enter ACT events.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

For the ACT Program, dogs may participate at any jump height determined by the owner. There are no Regular/Preferred splits for ACTs.

AWARDS

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to all qualifying dogs at the end of the each test.

New title ribbons will be awarded to those who complete a title or titles.

All ribbons will be awarded at the end of the day, none will be mailed.

BIS, AND INJURY REFUND INFORMATION

Any exhibitor with a bitch entered, which is in season on the trial date, will be refunded the entry fee. Documentation from veterinarian is NOT required. If your bitch comes into season during the trial, please advise the trial secretary and any subsequent runs will be refunded in full.

Injury/Illness – Dogs that cannot compete prior to the set of trials due to an injury/illness will be refunded the entry fee, less \$10.00 per run, upon written certification from a veterinarian. Notification with documentation from veterinarian must be in the hands of the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on each day. Validation of the injury/illness must be made by a licensed veterinarian. Requests from chiropractors, massage/physical therapists, etc will not be accepted. Handler illness/injury is excluded from this policy.

SITE INFORMATION

Benton/BTS Arena & Exhibition Center is an outdoor undercover facility with two 110 x 125 foot rings with a professionally groomed dirt surface.

The grounds will be available for setup for all exhibitors on Thursday from 3-6pm and each morning Friday, Saturday, and Sunday at 7:00am on each morning. Please bring your own crate, clean up supplies, & water for your dog. Consider bringing a tent, crating out of car, or renting a clean horse stall. There is ample parking onsite. Crating is available undercover on dirt. It is recommended that you bring a tarp or some other water-proof cover to use under your crates to protect from the dirt.

Please note: Spectator seating in the stands only.

All dogs must always be on leash, except when they are in the ring. Exercise and toilet your dog in designated areas. Please pick up poop and use garbage containers on the site. Please be courteous to others using the area. No aggressive dogs.

The Myrtle Beach Kennel Club and Benton/BTS Arena & Exhibition Center will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

*****PLEASE NOTE***:** GPS will get you close using 215 Bill Thompson Ln, Lake Waccamaw, NC.

A map will be provided with the final confirmation showing the last couple of turns to make sure that you are able to access the arena. Some GPS apps will take you straight to the location, while others will get you to where you can see the location, but not access it.

From the south: Take your shortest route to US-74E/US-76E. Follow US-74E/US-76E to Chauncey Town Rd. Follow below.

From the north/east: I-40E to I-95S to NC-210S/NC-53E in Fayetteville (Exit 49 from I-95S). Get on US-74E/US-76E in Hallsboro from NC-53E. Follow US-74E/US-76E to Chauncey Town Rd. Follow below.

From the west: Take US-74W/US-76W. Exit on Chauncey Town Rd. Follow below.

Follow Chauncey Town Rd to Sam Potts Hwy, NC-214 (Some GPS will try to turn you onto Top Tobacco Rd. This will not allow access to the arena) Turn right on NC-214. Turn right on Bill Thompson Ln. Follow Bill Thompson Ln to the arena

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. It is expressly understood that the exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made. All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. No dogs may be left tied to trees, cars, fences, etc.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not allowed at this trial. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that the dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. No classes will be held up by a late exhibitor.

This club does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

START TIMES

THURSDAY – DOS Entries taken from 3:30-4:30pm. Test walk-through times 4:45pm for round 1. First dog on the line 5:00pm. Round 2 to follow immediately following round 1.

FRIDAY & SATURDAY – DOS Entries taken all day until end of MBKC trials. Course build will be done immediately following completion of the trials each day. Walk-through expected to start approximately 20-30 minutes following completion of trials. First dog on the line immediately following walk through. Two rings will be utilized on Friday only. ACT1 will run Round 1 immediately followed by Round 2 in one ring. ACT2J will run Round 1 immediately followed by Round 2.

ACT INFORMATION

ACT is an entry-level test that is open to all dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class and that meet the age and physical requirements for a regular AKC agility trial.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine PartnersSM** applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
