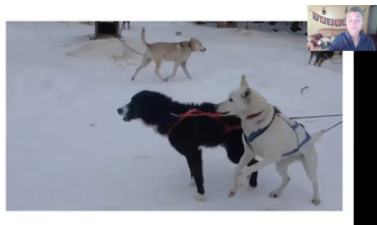
The Wild Approach Brings Virtual and Hybrid Meetings to Life
