### Christy Hamill Courage Award



#### A tribute to Christy

On September 22, 2024 – 6 days before the Run for Her – Christy Hamill posted a video on social media to challenge her friends and family to run, walk or donate on her behalf. Christy had been diagnosed with ovarian cancer in April 2024 and was in active treatment at the time.

By event day, Christy had gathered close to 30 teammates to walk alongside her. Her team collectively raised more than \$12,000 for the cause. Patient advocate volunteers Donna, Peggy and Karen selected Christy as the inaugural "Lady Balls" award recipient, to recognize her strength and determination to make an impact.




We were deeply saddened to learn of Christy's untimely death in March 2025, less than a year after her diagnosis.
