Core Curriculum: English and Mathematics form the core curriculum at City of Rochester School

Extending our pupils' literacy skills and numeracy ability form the foundation of the curriculum. Pupils will have regular lessons across both core subjects throughout all key stages of education. We recognise that pupils will enter City of Rochester school at different stages of their educational life and we aim to achieve the best possible outcomes for pupils from their entry point. Through high quality teaching will come outstanding learning. Pupils' individual needs will be carefully planned for and lessons differentiated to their ability. Promoting British Values:
