

## Healing Scriptures and Confessions

*All Scriptures NASB 1995 unless otherwise noted*

### Exodus 15:26

<sup>26</sup> And He said, “If you will give earnest heed to the voice of the Lord your God, and do what is right in His sight, and give ear to His commandments, and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have put on the Egyptians; for I, the Lord, am your healer.”

I earnestly listen to the voice of the Lord my God, and do what is right in his sight, giving ear to His commandments, and keeping all his statutes. He will not put the diseases of my former captors upon me, for He is the Lord that heals me.

### Exodus 23:25-26

<sup>25</sup> But you shall serve the Lord your God, and He will bless your bread and your water; and I will remove sickness from your midst. <sup>26</sup> There shall be no one miscarrying or barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.

I serve the Lord my God and He blesses my bread and water. He takes sickness away from my midst. No miscarriages or barrenness is in my family, and He will fulfil the number of my days.

### Deuteronomy 30:19-20

<sup>19</sup> I call heaven and earth to witness against you today, that I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. So choose life in order that you may live, you and your descendants, <sup>20</sup> by loving the Lord your God, by obeying His voice, and by holding fast to Him; for this is your life and the length of your days, that you may live in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them.”

I choose life, so I and my descendants may live, by loving the Lord my God, obeying His voice, and holding fast to Him; for He is my life and length of days.

### 2 Chronicles 16:9a

<sup>9</sup> For the eyes of the Lord move to and fro throughout the earth that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His.

My heart is completely the Lord's, so His eyes are upon me to strongly support me.

### Psalms 41:1-3

How blessed is he who considers the helpless;  
The Lord will deliver him in a day of trouble.

<sup>2</sup> The Lord will protect him and keep him alive,  
And he shall be called blessed upon the earth;  
And do not give him over to the desire of his enemies.

<sup>3</sup> The Lord will sustain him upon his sickbed;  
In his illness, You restore him to health.

I consider the helpless and the Lord delivers me in days of trouble. He protects me and keeps me alive. I am blessed upon the earth and have victory over my enemies. He will sustain me upon my sickbed; and in my illness He restores me to health.

#### **Psalm 84:11**

<sup>11</sup>For the Lord God is a sun and shield;  
The Lord gives grace and glory;  
No good thing does He withhold from those who walk uprightly.

God is not withholding any good thing from me because I walk uprightly.

#### **Psalm 91:9-10, 14-16**

<sup>9</sup>For you have made the Lord, my refuge,  
*Even* the Most High, your dwelling place.  
<sup>10</sup>No evil will befall you,  
Nor will any plague come near your tent.  
  
<sup>14</sup>“Because he has loved Me, therefore I will deliver him;  
I will set him *securely* on high, because he has known My name.  
<sup>15</sup>“He will call upon Me, and I will answer him;  
I will be with him in trouble;  
I will rescue him and honor him.  
<sup>16</sup>“With a long life I will satisfy him  
And let him see My salvation.”

I have made the Lord, my refuge, the Most High, my dwelling place; no evil will befall me, nor will any plague come near my tent. I have set my love upon Him, therefore He will deliver me and set me securely on high because I’ve known His name. I call upon Him and He answers me. He is with me in trouble, rescues me, and honors me. He satisfies me with long life and shows me His salvation.

#### **Psalm 103:1-5**

Bless the Lord, O my soul,  
And all that is within me, *bless* His holy name.  
<sup>2</sup>Bless the Lord, O my soul,  
And forget none of His benefits;  
<sup>3</sup>Who pardons all your iniquities,  
Who heals all your diseases;  
<sup>4</sup>Who redeems your life from the pit,  
Who crowns you with lovingkindness and compassion;  
<sup>5</sup>Who satisfies your years with good things,  
*So that* your youth is renewed like the eagle.

I bless the Lord with my soul and all that is within me. I do not forget any of His benefits—the one who pardons all my iniquities and heals all my diseases, who redeems my life from the pit, who crowns me with lovingkindness and compassion, and satisfies my years with good things, so my youth is renewed like the eagle’s.

### **Psalm 107:17-21**

Fools, because of their rebellious way,  
And because of their iniquities, were afflicted.  
<sup>18</sup> Their soul abhorred all kinds of food,  
And they drew near to the gates of death.  
<sup>19</sup> Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble;  
He saved them out of their distresses.  
<sup>20</sup> He sent His word and healed them,  
And delivered *them* from their destructions.  
<sup>21</sup> Let them give thanks to the Lord for His lovingkindness,  
And for His wonders to the sons of men!  
<sup>22</sup> Let them also offer sacrifices of thanksgiving,  
And tell of His works with joyful singing.

I cry to the Lord in my trouble and He saves me out of my distresses. He sent His Word and healed me and delivered me from my destructions. I give thanks to Him for His lovingkindness and tell of His works with joyful singing.

### **Psalm 118:17**

<sup>17</sup> I will not die, but live,  
And tell of the works of the Lord.

I will not die, but live, and tell of the works of the Lord.

### **Proverbs 4:20-24**

<sup>20</sup> My son, give attention to my words;  
Incline your ear to my sayings.  
<sup>21</sup> Do not let them depart from your sight;  
Keep them in the midst of your heart.  
<sup>22</sup> For they are life to those who find them  
And health to all their body.  
<sup>23</sup> Watch over your heart with all diligence,  
For from it *flow* the springs of life.  
<sup>24</sup> Put away from you a deceitful mouth  
And put devious speech far from you.

I pay attention to God's words and incline my ear to His sayings. I do not let them depart from my sight. I keep them in the midst of my heart, for they are life to me as I find them, and health to all my body.

### **Isaiah 53:4-5**

<sup>4</sup> Surely our griefs He Himself bore,  
And our sorrows He carried;  
Yet we ourselves esteemed Him stricken,  
Smitten of God, and afflicted.

<sup>5</sup> But He was pierced through for our transgressions,  
He was crushed for our iniquities;  
The chastening for our well-being *fell* upon Him,  
And by His scourging we are healed.

Jesus bore my griefs (sicknesses) and sorrows. He was pierced through for my transgressions and crushed for my iniquities. The chastening for my well-being fell on Him, and by His scourging I am healed.

#### **Isaiah 54:10-11**

<sup>10</sup> “For as the rain and the snow come down from heaven,  
And do not return there without watering the earth  
And making it bear and sprout,  
And furnishing seed to the sower and bread to the eater;  
<sup>11</sup> So will My word be which goes forth from My mouth;  
It will not return to Me empty,  
Without accomplishing what I desire,  
And without succeeding *in the matter* for which I sent it.

The Word of God goes which goes forth from His mouth, my mouth, because I am His body in the earth, will not return to Him empty without accomplishing what He desires it to do, and without succeeding in the matter for which He sent it.

#### **Jeremiah 1:12**

<sup>12</sup> Then the Lord said to me, “You have seen well, for I am watching over My word to perform it.”

God is watching over His Word to perform it.

#### **Joel 3:10 (AMPC)**

<sup>10</sup> Beat your plowshares into swords, and your pruning hooks into spears; let the weak say, I am strong [a warrior]!

I am not weak, I am a strong warrior!

#### **Matthew 8:2-3**

<sup>2</sup> And a leper came to Him and bowed down before Him, and said, “Lord, if You are willing, You can make me clean.” <sup>3</sup> Jesus stretched out His hand and touched him, saying, “I am willing; be cleansed.” And immediately his leprosy was cleansed.

Jesus is willing to heal me.

#### **Matthew 8:16-17**

<sup>6</sup> When evening came, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed; and He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were ill. <sup>17</sup> *This was* to fulfill what was spoken through Isaiah the prophet: “He Himself took our infirmities and carried away our diseases.”

Jesus cast out spirits with a word and healed all who were ill. He fulfilled what was spoken by Isaiah the prophet that He took my infirmities and bore my sicknesses.

#### **Mark 10:27**

<sup>27</sup> Looking at them, Jesus said, “With people it is impossible, but not with God; for all things are possible with God.”

I believe, so all things are possible to me, with God.

#### **Mark 16:14-18**

<sup>14</sup> Afterward He appeared to the eleven themselves as they were reclining *at the table*; and He reproached them for their unbelief and hardness of heart, because they had not believed those who had seen Him after He had risen. <sup>15</sup> And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. <sup>16</sup> He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved; but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned. <sup>17</sup> These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues; <sup>18</sup> they will pick up serpents, and if they drink any deadly *poison*, it will not hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.”

In His name, I lay hands on the sick and they will recover. When hands of believers are laid on me, I will recover.

#### **Luke 6:19**

<sup>19</sup> And all the people were trying to touch Him, for power was coming from Him and healing *them* all.

The power of Jesus heals all.

#### **John 14:27**

<sup>27</sup> Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you. Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful.

I have Jesus’ peace. I will not let my heart be troubled or fearful.

#### **John 16:27**

<sup>27</sup> for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me and have believed that I came forth from the Father.

The Father loves me, because I love Jesus and believe He came from the Father.

#### **Acts 3:16**

<sup>16</sup> And on the basis of faith in His name, *it is the name of Jesus which has strengthened this man whom you see and know; and the faith which comes through Him has given him this perfect health in the presence of you all.*

I have faith in the Name of Jesus, which strengthens me and gives me perfect health in the presence of all.

#### **Acts 10:38**

<sup>38</sup> *You know of Jesus of Nazareth, how God anointed Him with the Holy Spirit and with power, and how He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.*

Jesus was anointed with the Holy Spirit and power and went about doing good and healing all that were oppressed of the devil. The anointing of the Holy Spirit and power does good and heals.

#### **Romans 8:2, 11**

<sup>2</sup> *For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and of death.*

<sup>11</sup> *But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.*

The law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has set me from the law of sin and death. The Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in me, and He who raised Christ from the dead also gives life to my mortal body through His Spirit who dwells in me.

#### **2 Corinthians 2:14**

<sup>14</sup> *But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and manifests through us the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in every place.*

Thanks be to God who always leads me in triumph in Christ, and manifests through me the sweet aroma of the knowledge of Him in every place!

#### **Galatians 3:13-14, 29**

<sup>13</sup> *Christ redeemed us from the curse of the Law, having become a curse for us—for it is written, “Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree”—<sup>14</sup> in order that in Christ Jesus the blessing of Abraham might come to the Gentiles, so that we would receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.*

<sup>29</sup> *And if you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham’s descendants, heirs according to promise.*

Christ has redeemed me from the curse of the law, being made a curse for me, so that the blessing of Abraham might come on me through Jesus Christ. I belong to Christ, so this promise belongs to me. I am redeemed from the curse of every sickness and every plague (Deuteronomy 28:61).

#### **Philippians 1:6**

<sup>6</sup> *For I am confident of this very thing, that He who began a good work in you will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus.*

#### **Philippians 2:13**

<sup>13</sup> *for it is God who is at work in you, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.*

God is at work in me, both to will and to work for His good pleasure.

### **James 1:17**

<sup>17</sup>Every good thing given and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow.

Every good and perfect gift is from above and comes down to me from the Father of lights.

### **James 4:7**

<sup>7</sup>Submit therefore to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

I submit myself to God. I resist the devil, and he flees from me.

### **James 5:14-16**

<sup>14</sup>Is anyone among you sick? *Then* he must call for the elders of the church and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; <sup>15</sup>and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him. <sup>16</sup>Therefore, confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another so that you may be healed. The effective prayer of a righteous man can accomplish much.

The prayer of faith saves the sick and saves me.

### **1 Peter 2:24**

<sup>24</sup>and He Himself bore our sins in His body on the cross, so that we might die to sin and live to righteousness; for by His wounds you were healed.

Jesus bore my sins in His own body on the cross so that I, being dead to sins, should live to righteousness; by His stripes I was healed.

### **1 Peter 5:8-9**

<sup>8</sup>Be of sober *spirit*, be on the alert. Your adversary, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. <sup>9</sup>But resist him, firm in *your* faith, knowing that the same experiences of suffering are being accomplished by your brethren who are in the world.

I am sober and alert. I resist my adversary, the devil, firm in the faith.

### **1 John 4:16**

<sup>16</sup>We have come to know and have believed the love which God has for us. God is love, and the one who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him.

I have come to know, and believe in, the love which God has for me. I abide in love, therefore I abide in God, and God in me.

### **1 John 5:14-15**

<sup>14</sup>This is the confidence which we have before Him, that, if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. <sup>15</sup>And if we know that He hears us *in* whatever we ask, we know that we have the requests which we have asked from Him.

I have confidence that when I ask according to His will, he hears me, and knowing that He hears me, I know that I have the petitions I desire of Him.

### **3 John 2**

<sup>2</sup>Beloved, I pray that in all respects you may prosper and be in good health, just as your soul prospers.

His desire is for me to prosper and be in health, even as my soul prospers.

### **Revelation 12:11, Romans 12:1**

<sup>11</sup> And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death.

<sup>1</sup>Therefore I urge you, brethren, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, *which is* your spiritual service of worship.

I overcome by the blood of the Lamb and the word of my testimony. I do not love my life unto the death, but present my body a living and holy sacrifice to God, acceptable unto Him.
