

Prayer and Proclamation for America

A 52-day daily guide to prayer for a nation

Scripture:	Note:
Jonah 3:10	O God we, in America, turn from our wicked ways. We repent and fast. We cry out to You with our whole households. We ask that You relent from any destruction You could rightfully bring on us and our country.
Isaiah 66:1-2	God, we recognize that we cannot build a place that is worthy of You for You have made everything. Yet You look to dwell among the humble of heart, the contrite, with the one who trembles at Your Word. We humble ourselves in repentance and fear of You. Teach us Your Word O Lord and live among us.
Daniel 9:1-19	Lord, we confess that we have not kept your Word as we should. As a nation, we have sinned and been wicked. But we turn from all wickedness. "O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and take action! For Your own sake, O my God, do not delay" Fulfill Your righteous plan for America.
Acts 17:24-27	Lord, You do not live in buildings that we build. Nor do You need anything from us for You are the one who gives life and breath to people and all things. You have made all the nations from one man. You have determined their appointed times and the boundaries of their land. Your desire is that all of us would seek You, find You and touch You. You are within reach. We seek You now, to find You, and to implement Your ways and plans for America.
Proverbs 11:10-11	God, we ask for Your blessing on the righteous of our nation, states, counties, cities, townships, and villages. We ask for things to go well for the righteous, so we may rejoice and succeed in building Your kingdom, and be delivered from the destruction of the wicked.
Genesis 18:19	Just as You chose Abraham so he could command his children after him to keep Your way of righteousness and justice, so we follow You and teach our children to do the same. Forgive us for any neglect in teaching our children Your ways.
Ezekiel 29:6-7	Lord, we support Israel. Not to take away from their trust in You, and not to be a false support – a façade – either. We support her, yet point her to You, not attempting to take Your place in her nation.
Isaiah 5:20-23	We align our thinking with Yours so we call evil what You call evil. We call good what You call good. We judge all things according to Your standards – Your truth, Your Word, Your righteousness.
Psalms 22:27-31	We speak of You to the coming generation. We teach, write, record, sing, and tell of Your righteousness and all Your ways, so those yet to be born can learn Your ways and worship You. Forgive us God, for neglecting to do this.
Psalms 86:11	"Teach me Your way, O Lord. I will walk in Your truth. Unite my heart to fear Your name."
Judges 9:50-57	When it seems that we are surrounded by enemies, You have a way to deliver. Put in our hand what we need to bring deliverance to our nation. Give us the insight and the courage to use what You've given us to bring deliverance.
Esther 4:14-16	Lord, let us see our purpose in this hour. Give us the courage and favor we need for You have placed us where we are for a reason – for such a time as this. Your purposes and Your laws are above man's.
1 Corinthians 11:23-26	Lord Jesus, we remember You. We remember what You've done for us, how You've suffered for us, and the victory You've given us over death and the grave. You've given us victory over sin and unrighteousness. We remember, and will not forget.
2 Chronicles 20:20-23	Lord, we assemble before You with our families and children, to fast and pray for the safety and deliverance of our nation. We trust in You. We trust in Your prophets who speak for You. We go forward with praise and righteousness as our first priority. You are the Lord who sets ambushes against our enemies.
2 Corinthians 5:18-21	We are Your ambassadors. We proclaim the same word of reconciliation that we've received from You. America – be reconciled to God!
Joshua 24:14-15	As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord. We make that choice.

Exodus 3:1-10	God, we know You hear our prayers and our cries. Now raise up the leaders who will answer Your call and be used to deliver us in this hour.
Deuteronomy 8:11-20	Lord we thank You for all of the ways You have blessed our nation. Our times of scarcity teach us that You never fail us, and we could not survive without You. We will remember You always, in both good times and bad, whether we are full or hungry.
Genesis 12:1-3	You will bless those who bless Israel. We bless Israel today and pray for the nation and Jewish people to find Your salvation.
Deuteronomy 32:28-30	God we understand that America's strength has come from You – the Rock. We determine to remember this, that any success America has is due to You. Our enemies do not have victory over us because of You.
Proverbs 21:31	Victory belongs to the Lord! Our victory is only found in Him.
Genesis 1:26-28	God we are made in Your image and likeness. You made us male and female and gave us authority to rule in the Earth. Forgive us for abdicating the responsibilities and authority You've given to the marriage and family unit – the greatest ruling authority in the Earth.
Malachi 3:8-12	God forgive us for any way that we've robbed You, for not giving You what is due to You. We give of our substance, our time, our words, our energy, and our space to You. Rebuke the devourer for our sakes.
Acts 5:27-32	The gospel of the kingdom and teaching in the name of Jesus must continue. We will obey God first and foremost over any conflicting laws of man.
Genesis 9:12-15	The rainbow – the covenant sign of Your promise to never again destroy the Earth by flood. When we see the rainbow, we will honor You Lord and thank You for Your covenant with us.
Proverbs 25:28	We determine to protect our borders, especially the borders of our heart. Forgive us for compromising and allowing unrighteous thoughts into our minds and hearts, our children, and our nation.
2 Timothy 2:3-4	As a good soldier of Christ Jesus, we will not become bogged down with the affairs of everyday life. We will please the One who enlisted us into His army, His kingdom.
Isaiah 58	Lord, teach us to fast and pray. We humble ourselves to loosen the bonds of wickedness, undo the bands of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and break every yoke. We share with the hungry, the poor, the naked. May our light break out and our recovery come quickly. May our righteousness in Christ go before us and Your glory be our rear guard. We call on You and You answer when we fast as You desire.
Genesis 50:15-21	God, we repent of and resist all bitterness we might feel which has come because of the circumstances that brought us to the place we are in now. We are positioned for You to use us for good. What the enemy meant for evil, turn around for good!
1 Samuel 16:7	God, help us to judge people, especially those who are called to be leaders, according to Your ways – by Your standards, not man's. By the heart and not the outward appearance. Give us Your wisdom and insight so we may vote and make choices that forward Your purposes on Earth.
1 Samuel 17:45	Our enemy may come with intimidating weapons against us, but we stand in the name of the Lord of hosts. Our enemy may taunt us, but we, Your people, stand in the name of Jesus. In the victory He has purchased for us.
Judges 7:2	Lord, we tear down the altars and idols of false gods and worship only You. We know it doesn't take a large army to win the fight You've called us to. We know we don't win in our own power and will not try and boast of that. You are our only deliverer.
Psalms 47	We clap our hands and shout to God with the voice of joy! You are the King of the Earth, the most High who reigns over the nations and sits on Your holy throne!
Psalms 33:16-22	It is not our strength or great army that saves us. Lord, You look on those who fear You and hope in Your lovingkindness. We do fear You and look to You for our deliverance. Our heart rejoices in You because we trust in You.

Psalm 91	Lord, You are our refuge, our fortress, our God in whom we trust! We dwell in Your shelter, Your shadow, and under Your wings. Thank You for Your deliverance and protection – for Your angels who guard all our ways. We love You and call upon You. Thank You for answering, rescuing, honoring, and satisfying us with long life and salvation.
1 Samuel 30:1-8	We do as David did when he and his men’s homes were destroyed in Ziklag, and their wives and children captured. We take time to inquire of You O Lord. We don’t act out of despair and fear, but we seek You and Your will, and instruction on what to do. We will do what You say.
Psalm 121	Lord, we look to You. We know You are our help. You, who never sleeps. There is no other for us to look to for help. We trust You completely, knowing Your goodness and lovingkindness.
Psalm 127	Lord, we look to You to build our homes. We look to You to guard our cities. It is vain for us to think we can protect ourselves without You. We trust in You and have no need to worry.
2 Chronicles 16:7-9	The eyes of the Lord look to and fro throughout the whole earth to strongly support those whose heart is completely His. We give our heart completely to You Lord, and remain consistently faithful.
2 Corinthians 5:17	In Christ, we are a new creature. Old things have passed away, new things have come.
Hebrews 9:11-14	Jesus Christ, the holy High Priest, offered Himself as the sacrifice for our sin. Through His blood, our consciences are purged from dead works so we may serve a living God. We no longer follow our own dead works – our attempts at righteousness our way – but we submit to the plan of God through Jesus Christ our High Priest.
Psalm 37	We do not fret because of evildoers, or envy them. They will fade away. We trust in You Lord and do good. We commit our way to You. We rest in You and will inherit the land. Though the wicked plot against the righteous, You laugh at them. You sustain the righteous and provide. We will be gracious and generous with all that You give us Lord. We stand in the righteousness of Jesus Christ, not our own.
2 Samuel 24:10-14	The mercies of God are greater than the mercies of man. We choose Your mercy Lord, even in times of judgment and repentance!
Psalm 72	Let Your righteous leaders rule this land O Lord. Let them rule according to Your righteous judgments. Let them vindicate the afflicted and needy and stand against the oppressor. Let the fear of You, peace, and righteousness flourish in their days. Let them rule from sea to shining sea. We bless You Lord. Let the whole Earth be filled with Your glory.
1 Timothy 2:1-2	We pray for all who are in authority so we may lead a quiet, tranquil, and godly life. We the church, pray this for the benefit of all people, even those who are not praying or seeking God themselves.
1 Samuel 8:4-7	Lord, we repent for every way we have rejected You from being King over us. We submit to You and those You have chosen as leaders.
2 Samuel 22:47-51	We give thanks to You Lord for Your deliverance and lovingkindness. Thank You for delivering us from our rejection of You and Your ways.
Ezekiel 8:16-18	Lord, we repent of idolatry, of putting anything in our lives above You, before You, or as a higher priority than You. We cry out for mercy and grace. Help us to set our priorities right.
2 Chronicles 7:12-14	In the midst of the consequences of rejecting You, You still respond when Your people humble themselves and pray, seek Your face, and turn from wickedness. You hear, forgive, and heal their land. We do so now Lord, and ask that You hear, forgive, and heal our land.
Ecclesiastes 9:14-18	God’s wisdom can deliver a land from even the strongest enemies through a humble, quiet heart that is not looking for recognition or attention. God, we humbly ask that You grant us this wisdom so we are delivered from those trying to conquer our land.

Matthew 1:18-23	Lord, thank You for coming and living among us as a man. Thank You for sacrificing Yourself for us. You are still with us, in our hearts as we believe in You. We thank You for never leaving us or forsaking us.
Jonah 2:1-9	Lord, we repent for our lack of courage in not taking a stand against wickedness or warning of the consequence of sin. We repent for our lack of love in not caring about those who are on the verge of suffering judgment because of their sin. We choose to answer the call You have placed on us, and will do our part in this hour.
