- 1. Each owner is responsible for making sure that all items are off their balcony at least 48 hours prior to an approaching storm. If you are out of town, you MUST have someone who will be able to prepare your unit prior and check for damage after the storm. If you are leaving for an extended period, it is encouraged you remove all items off your balcony and secure your unit prior to leaving. This is NOT the responsibility of the association.
- 2. After the storm employees will be back on property as soon as they are allowed and will assess common area damage.
- 3. Please be patient in trying to reach the Castaways after a storm as power, phones lines and internet may be down for several days. We will do our best to communicate with everyone by email, if we have one on file, as soon as we are able. If you have not provided your email to the association, it is highly encouraged.
