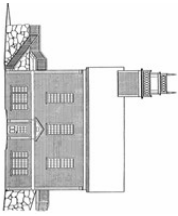

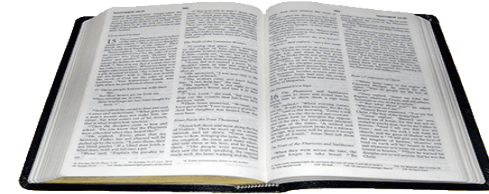

It's September. Unbelievable, but the calendar tells us this is so, as do the flower and vegetable gardens. Perhaps your houseplants have enjoyed time outside during these warmer months, but now it is time to begin to bring them back indoors as the evening temperatures become uncomfortably chilly. Officially, the 3rd week of the month is National Indoor Plant Week. Several books in the library, FLOWERING HOUSE PLANTS, FOLIAGE HOUSEPLANTS and CROCKETT'S INDOOR GARDEN, include useful information to successfully acclimate your plants back into indoor living, as they also improve your own healthy indoor environment during the winter months ahead.

Interesting days to celebrate this month include No News is Good News Day-Sept 11, Blame Someone Else Day- Sept 13, Ask a Stupid Question Day- Sept 28 and, the best, National Cream-Filled Donut Day-Sept 14.






Monday, September 16th, is designated Collect Rocks Day. Children can be excellent 'rock hounds' and a couple books may appeal especially to these young searchers. With wonderful description and photography, IF YOU FIND A ROCK, celebrates the variety of rocks that can be found, including skipping rocks, chalk rocks, worry rocks, fossil rocks and memory rocks. RHODA'S ROCK HUNT is a story about a young girl who loves rocks, collecting as she hikes through the forest, across the river to the Big Lake until her pack is too heavy to move. She can't leave her treasures. She loves all her beautiful rocks, but staying on the beach forever with them isn't a good idea either.
