# **Twelve-Bar Blues**

This is a very common pattern of song that uses just three chords. It is also the basis for almost every rock 'n' roll song from "Hound Dog" and "Tutti Futti" onwards.

The pattern is very straighforward it uses chords based around the 1st, 4th and 5th notes of a scale. So, for a blues in C, the chords are C, F and G (usually G7). For a blues in G, the chords are G, C and D7.

The pattern is 12 bars long and is repeated for each verse. The timing is almost always 4 beats in the bar or 4/4 time and the most common strum is the Nashville strum - **D DUDUDU 12&3&4&** 

Here is the pattern for a blues in C.
